Sir,

With due respect, I PSI Laksung Bhutia of Bagdogra P.S. SPC hereby lodge a complaint against the following arrested accused persons namely i) Md Kuddus 20yrs s/o Md Rafik of Muni Jote PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling ii) Sanjay Sah 40yrs s/o Lt. Basundeb Sah of Jyotinagar PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling iii) Papan Sah @ Swapan Sah 22yrs s/o Sunil Sah of Tailakhya Nagar PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling iv) Kamal Nandi 35yrs s/o Lt. RadhaGobinda Nandi of Netaji Polly Shibmandir PO, Kadamtala PS, Matigara Dist. Darjeeling v) Sanjay Pathak 35yrs s/o Pritambar Pathak of Railway Colony Station More PS, Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling for disobeying order of wearing of facial mask vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021.

The facts of the case in brief is that today on 28/04/2021 at about 13.55 hrs in course of my K-35 Mobile Van duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 2011 Dated 28/04/2021 the above noted arrested persons were found was roaming at Bagdogra bazaar area without wearing face mask as the Government of West Bengal has issued order vide Memo no 486/CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 that wearing of facial mask made mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation that since the COVID-19 pandemic crisis is grave, all persons are to strictly comply with the COVID-19 safety norms of wearing face mask and maintaining social distance whenever they go out in public place. Accordingly, I stop them and ask their reason for not wearing mask but they could not give any satisfactory reason. It is pertinent to note here that since the outbreak of Second wave of Corona Virus awareness regarding wearing of face mask and social distancing had been conducted through milking but the above persons had no botheration regarding their own safety and also the safety of others. Their such act is dangerous so as to the spread of Corona Virus. Thereafter, I tried to convince them and directed them to wear face mask and maintained social distance but they denied to do so and started arguing with me. Finding no other alternative way, I apprehended them to avoid risks to human life and health.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I request you that a specific case against the aforementioned persons may kindly started with suitable sections of law.
