On dated 30.06.2021 no 99009920 Hc Govinda Rao of 180 Bn BSF a/w 03 or's det perform second shift ACP duty in the AOR of Bop Fulbari fm BFL No 10 to 19 and er to dominate the AOR from Bp No. 732/1-S To 732/5-S From 292345 Hrs To 300600 124539213 Ct Anil Pal of 45 Bn BSF attached with ICP Fulbari was entrusted to duty fm BFL No 13 to 16. At about 0320 hrs No.124539213 Ct Anil Pal observed suspicious movement of smugglers/miscreants trying to approach IBB fence along w cattles in alignment of BP No. 732/4-S between BFL No. 15 & 16 and picket No 323 No. 124539213 Ct Anil Pal immediately actively reacted and informed to other mem ACP party and patrolling party, rushed towards the spot and challenge smugglers/miscreants. On being challenged the smugglers/miscreants did not paid an and tried to forcefully smuggle the cattles. To deterred the smugglers, No. 124539213 C Pal fired one cartridge of PAG (butt no 68 and body no 26266). On hearing the sound smugglers/miscreants run away from the spot taking advantages of darkness, undt ground, thicked grasses/bushes and inclement weather. ACP & patrolling party search surrounding area and recovered 04 nos cattle (haryana origin, big size) (male) @ 22,52: rs. 90,092/- and detected fence breach in between BFL pole no. 15 & 16 corresponding no 732/4-S. Coy 2IC, Inspr A K Mondal who was also performing patrolling duty a time in the coy AOR rushed towards the incident spot and the matter was informed t commander through radio set. Tracker dog was also called on the spot for sniffing the a incidence.
