With due respect, I Gangita Roy, 20/o. Bipul Barman, Aged 26 yrs, R/o. Tripali Jote, P/o. Nimai, P/s. Matigara, Dist. Darjeeling would like to lodge a complaint against my husband Bipul Barman, s/o. Prem Charan Barman, Aged 27 yrs, my mother-in-law Joshua Barman, w/o. Prem Charan Barman, Aged 52 yrs, my father-in-law Prem Charan Barman, Aged 58 yrs, and my sister-in-law Monica Barman, Aged 19 yrs, all are resident of Tripali Jote, P/o. Nimai, P/s. Matigara, Dist. Darjeeling that we married in the temple on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2014, and happily lived as husband and wife. Out of the marriage a male child was born on 23.03.2020. Everything was going fine but during this lockdown/restriction period, I asked my

my husband to go and meet his family and give away few essential items so rice, vegetables, etc in goodness and hum. In return from his mother's home, he (Bipul Barman) started quarrelling, beating me with fist, blows and kicks and even tried to strangulate me with a dupatta but soon I managed to save myself and wriggled off his grip on around 15.07.2001. He then ran away from home with no clue where I went. From well-wisher, I came to know my husband is in his mother's house. So (10.08.2001) morning along with some 18 (eighteen) female went to my husband's / mother's-in-law's house but they did not let me inside house as they started saying that they have arranged a woman for marrying Bipul Barman. As I am not the choice of my husband's family. Now, I with my 1.5 yrs son is homeless and cannot go back to my mother's house as it was our love marriage and had

married against their (my parents) will.

I am convinced that if my husband, mother-in-law, father-in-law and my sister-in-law mentioned above is let free to roam then my and my child's life will be under constant threat and danger.

Under this circumstances, I pray before your authority to grant me relief by arresting him, my mother-in-law, father-in-law and sister-in-law at the earliest as they may abscond. Delay in arresting them may cause irreparable loss and damages. Their release on bail against the complaint filed may make mad to take revenge on me.

I shall ever be grateful before your gracious authority.
