I, Prity Agarwala, Wife of Late Vishwanath Agarwal, Daughter of Late Jagannath Agarwal, presently Residing At Laxmi Niwas, M.R. Road, Khalpara, Siliguri-734005, do hereby wants to bring to your notice the following facts:

1. That I got married to Vishwanath Agarwal @ Vishu Agarwal (now deceased), Son of Amarnath Gupta on 24th May, 2015 at Soubhagya Palace, Punjabi Para, Siliguri as per Hindu rites and customs.
2. That after the marriage, I started to reside with my in-laws - Mother-in-Law -Smt. Seema Gupta, Father-in-Law -Sri. Amarnath Gupta, and 3 (Three) Sister-in-Laws, namely Miss Rekha Agarwal, Miss Surabhi Agarwal, and Miss Saloni Gupta, Brother-in-law Vizay Gupta and sister in-law Meena Agarwal at my matrimonial house situated at Sri Krishna Complex, Asharam ~~Palace~~ ^{Para Ward No. 14.} Siliguri, however presently my matrimonial house is at 2nd Floor, opposite Model Town -II, Iskcon Road, Siliguri-734001, ^{where they shifted after the death of my husband.}
3. That during the initial days of the marriage, everything was fine but as days passed by, my Mother -in- law started behaving in an unusual manner and started picking fights with me in every minor situation. However I, due to my upbringing kept quiet and tolerated everything.

It may be noted that my mother-in-law was the step-mother of my husband and my husband often stated that my mother-in-law always looked down upon him and in the same manner, she ill-treated me.

4. That after few months of the marriage my in-laws started showing their dissatisfaction with my gifts and standard of living. They often used to taunt me and force me to bring money, jewelry and other expensive gifts from my parents and when I used to deny they used to humiliate me in front of others.

14. That from some sources it came to my knowledge that my deceased husband has left some properties behind which includes flat in a residential apartment Green Vyom, two Shops, a garage and some LIC Policies.
15. That my in-laws have now taken over my husband's shop namely New Fashion World situated at Gauri Shankar Market and all the cash and stock. They are also trying to take the possession of all other properties in the name of my husband. They have denied providing me with any documents in relation to the properties. Moreover all my jewellery and stridhan are also lying in my matrimonial house and they are hell-bent not to return the same or provide any share in any property left by my deceased husband.
16. That my husband's properties and my jewellery is my only source of survival and means to start a new life but because of my in-laws greedy nature, I am left helpless and devastated. I have become completely depended on my brother and his family
17. That numerous meeting were held by my well-wishers and relatives wherein they have agree to provide me my share but all their promises and assurances are false and shallow.
18. That my in-laws are causing huge mental harassment, agony and pain to me and now it has become intolerable and I have started feeling unwanted, depressed and suicidal.

Therefore, in these situations, finding no other alternative I came before you and prays for taking necessary legal action against the above named persons for such type abuse, harassment and mental torture.
