It is apparent that the modalidf ties of section 154 (3) and section 36 of Criminal Procedure Code 1973 has been complied with. Thus the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court given in Lalita Kumari versus State of U.P [2014] 2 SCC 1 and Priyanka Srivastava and another versus State of UP and others [2015]6 SCC 287 have been complied with.

It is reiterated here that as per order of the Hon'ble High Court in CRM 4792/2019 FIR shall be drawn up at the police station not later than 24 hours from the date of receipt of order u/s 156(3) Cr.P.C. and non compliance of the same will entail action u/s 23 Police Act and departmental action also.
