Sir,

In producing herewith the following arrested accused persons namely (i) Santosh Bhujel (41) S/O Gopal Bhujel of Bhaktinagar, Rajaholi, Ward No. 35 (ii) Rahul Paswan (20) S/O Udan Paswan of Sahid Colony, Ward No. 35 (iii) Mahadeb Debnath (23) S/O Dhaneswar Debnath of I.O.C. Road, Janata Para, Ward No.- 35 (iv) Ganesh Maji (34) S/O Pannalal Maji of South Colony, Bhola More (v) Md. Ajiz S/O Md. Ishak of Rajaholi, Ward no. - 35, (vi) Md. Adil (37) S/O Lt. Md. Aktar of Rajaholi, (vii) Md. Nasiruddin (29) S/O Md. Alim of Rajaholi all of P.S.- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri, alongwith following seized articles viz.

1. 03 (three) no.s of Iron Rod, measuring about 3 ½ ' (feet) X 9 m.m.
2. 22 no.s of Cane Stick in which some are broken condition.
2. Huge amount of stone/brick stone in a white coloured big Plastic bag

In this regard I beg to state that I SI Azizul Haque alongwith C/1028 B. Pariyar and C/988 B. Biswas all of New Jalpaiguri P.S. were engaged to perform morning and night Mobile patrol duty from 31/10/21 to 01/11/21, vide C.C. No. 2105/21, Dated 31/10/21. Today on 01/11/21 at about 07:40 hrs on getting information from O/C NJP P.S. myself alongwith force had been to NJP Truck parking area beside NJP R/Station. We reached there at about 07:50 hrs and found that above noted arrested accused persons alongwith (i) Md. Alauddin, (ii) Madan Mahato (iii) Md. Afroj (iv) Md. Hafij (v) Md. Ujaley (vi) Md. Salauddin alongwith 70/80 others present there. Everybody was threatening, abusing with filthy languages to each other. We tried to keep them quite. On asking they stated that there is a problem going on since last 3/4 days between 02 (two) groups of Truck syndicates on the issue of loading and unloading of Rail raked goods. I asked them not to make any L/O problem there and settle the matter anywhere leaving this parking place. Suddenly both the parties started assaulting to each other by fist and blows, using Iron rod, Cane lathi, Stone brick etc. We tried hard to stop them but the unruly mob attacked on us as well as on our Govt. Police vehicle, resulting all of us sustained injuries on our persons and our Govt vehicle got damaged. Immediate re-enforcement team of Police arrived there. We could manage to arrest above noted 05 (five) accused persons from the spot, remaining accused persons managed to escape from there, who were directly assaulted us also pelted stone towards us as well as on Govt. vehicle, also seized the above noted articles. Later, all of us arrived before Dist. Hospital, Siliguri for treatment, where it could be detected that C/988 Bhakta Biswas sustained bone fracture injury on his left arm, myself alongwith C/1028 B. Pariyar and other police personnel sustained simple injuries. Arrest and seizure were made within 08:30 hrs to 09:25 hrs. It seems that gathering was well prepared with deadly weapons to commit a big rioting.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against arrested accused persons namely (i) Santosh Bhujel (41) S/O Gopal Bhujel of Bhaktinagar, Rajaholi, Ward No. 35 (ii) Rahul Paswan (20) S/O Udan Paswan of Sahid Colony, Ward No. 35 (iii) Mahadeb Debnath (23) S/O Dhaneswar Debnath of I.O.C. Road, Janata Para, Ward No.- 35 (iv) Ganesh Maji (34) S/O Pannalal Maji of South Colony, Bhola More (v) Md. Ajiz S/O Md. Ishak of Rajaholi, Ward no. - 35, (vi) Md. Adil (37) S/O Lt. Md. Aktar of Rajaholi (vii) Md. Alauddin, (viii) Madan Mahato (ix) Md. Nasiruddin (29) S/O Md. Alim of Rajaholi (x) Md. Afroj (xi) Md. Hafij (xii) Md. Ujaley (xiii) Md. Salauddin along with 70/80 others on the ground of Unlawful assembly with deadly weapons, causing simple and grievous injuries to the police personnel on duty, damaging of Govt. vehicle at the time of COVID-19 situation.
