Subject: **FORCEFUL & ILLEGAL ATTEMPT TO DISPOSES THE RECORDED OWNER OF LAND FROM HIS OWN LEGALLY PURCHASED LAND.**

Respected Sir,

With due regards I Sri Dipak Basak, S/O Late Fanindra Nath Basak, Resident of Halderpara, P.S: Bhaktinagar, Dist: Jalpaiguri, would like to draw your kind attention to the fact that I have purchased a land from Anima Roy, recorded owner of the land schedule of which is mentioned below vide Deed of Conveyance, being Deed No: 2185/2002 dated 29/04/2002, registered from the office of D.S.R Jalpaiguri. At the time of purchasing the land I have thoroughly verified /made searching of various chain deeds from where the ownership of the land came to me & after proper verification I have purchased the said land. After purchasing the land for about 20 years I have enjoyed the peaceful possession as well as lawful right, title, interest over the said land without any interruption from any corner of the society. Recently about 2 months ago when I visited my land I found that all of a sudden some persons of the nearby locality namely 1) Anil @ Alin Roy, S/O Taten Roy, R/O Bholanath Para, P.S: Bhaktinagar, Jalpaiguri, 2) Prasanta Roy, S/O: Ghena Roy, R/O Chaytan Para, Ward No: 37, of S.M.C Jalpaiguri are creating disturbance for me from entering into my own recorded land. When I tried to resist them they illegally started claiming that the said land belongs to them & I have no right to enter into this land. They further started to terrorize me with dire consequence if I want to protest them in their illegal claim.

It is pertinent to mention here that the said accused persons are land grabbers & land mafias of Siliguri (May be land related cases pending against them) & it is their illegal activity of creating artificial nuisance in order to squeeze heavy amount of money from the actual owners of the land. They further demanded Rs: 30,00,000/- (Thirty Lacs) from me which I denied to fulfill. They are very dangerous in nature having no regard for the law & police administration.

In order to wrongfully taking the possession of the land they filed a false case before Ld. Executive Magistrate Sadar Jalpaiguri, stating that they have possession of the land but I challenged the order passed by Ld. Executive Magistrate Sadar Jalpaiguri, before Ld. District Judge Jalpaiguri & Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass an order in my favour and allowed STAY ORDER over the impugned order earlier passed by executive magistrate.

Therefore it is my humble request before the concerned authority to kindly look into this matter with utmost care & after proper investigation take action against the accused persons as per provisions of law.
