I, LPSI Supriya Barman of New Jalpaiguri Police Station, SPC do here by lodged this written complaint against the above noted persons to the effect that today (12/01/22) in between 18:15 Hrs and 20:15 Hrs in course of performing C.S mobile duty I along with force went to Naukaghat More area, PS- NJP, Jalpaiguri and found (1) Binod Ram (46 Yrs) S/o Late Harkishan Ram of D.S.Colony, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri, (2) Gabid Basfore (21 Yrs) S/o Late Raj Kumar Basfore of D.S. Colony, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (3) Rakesh Sahani (31 Yrs) S/o Ram Uday Sahani of Bhaktinagar near Central Bank, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (4) Bulu Roy (40 yrs) S/o Late Chandan Roy of Bhaktinagar Bazar, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (5) Munna Paswan (32 Yrs) S/o Mahesh Paswan of D.S.Colony,, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (6) Jiten Sha (38 Yrs) S/o Ram Nath Sha of D.S.Colony i, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (7) Md. On interrogation they also stated that they were well aware of Govt. order regarding pandemic situations and wearing of facemasks was mandatory in public places in the current pandemic situation.

They all are violated the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2029 Dtd. 02/01/2022 regarding pandemic situations.. Hence, I arrested them under proper memo of arrest in between 15:05 Hrs and 16:05 Hrs and duly signed by them in presence of witnesses and inform the ground of arrest.

Hence, I, request you for starting a specific case U/S 188/269/270 IPC r/w sec 51 (b) of disaster Management Act.2005 against the above noted accused persons and arrange proper investigation of the case.
