Respected Sir,

With due regards, I, **SMT. MAMONI SARKAR**, Wife of Sri Nilay Sarkar, Daughter of Sri Ajay Sarkar, Presently residing at Dabgram - I, Uday Colony, P.O. & P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling would like to lodge this written complaint to the effect that my marriage was solemnized on 08.03.2009 with Sri Nilay Sarkar, Son of Sri Samar Sarkar, of Madhy Dabgram, Near Loknath Mandir, P.O. Dabgram - II, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri and my husband also reside at Satrana, Rajasthan, FTR, HQ, BSF, Jodhpur according to the Hindu Rites and customs. After my marriage, I, along with my husband have started to live and co-habited together as husband and wife at my matrimonial house as mentioned aforesaid along and out of our lawful wedlock, two female children were born on 11.11.2011 and 08.08.2016 and their names are Miss. Tannisha Sarkar and Miss. Nilanjana Sarkar with. Since the date of my marriage, my husband at the instigation of his family members started to create pressure upon me to bring a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- from my parents and when I refused to bring the same, my husband and his family members in conspiracy with each other have started to create tremendous mental and physical torture upon me but I bear all such type of inhuman torture of my husband and in laws members with a hope that in near future they will realize their mistake and rectify themselves but all my hopes have gone in vain and ultimately, after elapse of 10 years of our marriage, I was driven out from my matrimonial house on 12.11.2019 due to non-fulfillment of their demand of more dowry and finding no other alternative, I was compelled to take shelter at my parental house and during my stay at my parental house after being driven out from my matrimonial house, my parents along with our well wishers have visited to the house of my husband to settle the disputes considering our future conjugal life as well as the future career of our two minor daughters and every time, my husband and his family members abused my parents and relatives with filthy and abusive languages and also threatened us with dire consequences by saying that until and unless my parents will not fulfill their further demands, they will not accept me in their house. In the mean time, myself along with my family members have made several attempts and request my husband and in laws members to restore our conjugal life as still now I am ready and willing to lead a conjugal life with my husband on and from my matrimonial house for the sake of future career of my our two minor daughter but every time, due to their adamant and reluctant attitude and behavior, our marital life could not be restored till now. Thereafter, I have filed one application U/S 12,17,18,19,20,22 and 23 of the

Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act against my husband and in laws members vide Misc. Case No. 04 of 2020 for proper remedy and the said application is pending before the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 4th Court at Siliguri and during pendency of the said application, they took my elder daughter in their custody for some period and later on, my elder daughter returned back to my parental house. From the mouth of my elder daughter Miss Tannesha Sarkar, I along with my family members came to learn that during the subsistence of our marriage, my husband again married with another lady namely Smt. Ranita Debnath of Haider Para, Ward No. 40 of SMC, Siliguri and started to reside with her as husband and wife. Not only that, my husband also took my elder daughter in the house of said Ranita Debnath and kept her in the said house and during her stay in the said house, my husband and the said lady Ranita Debnath tortured upon my daughter also both physically and mentally and after hearing the same, I went to the said house in order to verify the said information and after discussion with the lady of the said house, I have confirmed the said fact and immediately after receiving the said fact, my parents-in-law started to threaten me with dire consequences and also threatened me if I lodge complaint or inform the same to any authority, they will not hesitate to ruin my life permanently. Sir, since the date of my marriage, my husband and my parents-in-law have started tremendous torture upon me due to the non-fulfillment of their further demand of dowry and presently, I have been passing my days with my two minor daughters in extreme fear and anxiety.

I, therefore, request you to investigate into the matter and please take appropriate legal actions against my husband and other in-laws members as per the provision of law and obliged thereby.
