Sir,

In producing herewith one accused person namely Ramesh Roy (65) s/o late Subal Roy of Baikuntha pally ward no 41 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. Fifteen (15) bottles of Officers choice deluxe whisky each bottle containing 180 ml 2. Four (04) Bottles of 60 UP Himalayan Gold Country Spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. 03. Five bottles of Royal Blue premium whiskey each bottle containing 750 ml.

I, PSI Sailesh Subba of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC lodged a written complainant against the above noted person that today i.e. on 21.03.2022 at 22.05 hrs received a source information that the above noted person have gathered huge amount of liquor illegally in his shop at Baikuntha Pally, ward no 41 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri and selling the same in the open market to his design customer for his wrongful gain. This refers to Bhaktinagar PS GDE No-1503 Dated 21.03.2022. I informed I.C Bhaktinagar PS about the information. As per his kind instruction I along with, SI Sk Tamid Ali and along with accompanied constable 374 Debraj Biswas CV 014 Labanamoy Barman CV 619 Dharmendra Roy, proceeded to Baikuntha Pally in the shop of above noted person to work out the information. At about 22.20 hrs I along with SI Sk Tamzid Ali and my accompanied force reached at the spot, and being identified by the source we held raid in the shop of the above noted person and recovered the same viz i.e 1. Fifteen (15) bottles of Officers choice deluxe whisky each bottle containing 180 ml 2. Four (04) Bottles of 60 UP Himalayan Gold Country Spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. 03. Five bottles of Royal Blue premium whiskey each bottle containing 750 ml, from the possession of Ramesh Roy (65) s/o late Subal Roy of Baikuntha pally ward no 41 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri on demand he failed to produce any valid license or documents in the support of the said liquor. During interrogation he admitted his guilt before us and stated that he sells the same to his design customers since long time for his wrongful gain, accordingly I seized the above noted articles viz 1. Fifteen (15) bottles of Officers choice deluxe whisky each bottle containing 180 ml 2. Four (04) Bottles of 60 UP Himalayan Gold Country Spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. 03. Five bottles of Royal Blue premium whiskey each bottle containing 750 ml, as per proper seizure list duly sign by the accused person as well as witnesses. The seizure was made between 22.30 hrs to 22.55 hrs. Then I arrested him u/s 41 Cr.P.C. and issued Memo of arrest and appraising him the ground of arrest in presence of witnesses.

I therefore request you a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Ramesh Roy (65) s/o late Subal Roy of Baikuntha pally ward no 41 PS- Bhaktinagar Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law.
