In producing herewith the arrested accused person namely Mubarik (26 yrs) S/O Fate Mahammad of Vill- Guraksar, PO-+PS- Hatin, Dist.- Paluwal, Hariyana (Not verified) and the following articles under seizure viz:-

- 1) One Truck displaying number plate RJ/14/GJ/7023 loaded with Teak timber total 32 (Thirty two) numbers of loges (measurement mentioned in seizure list)
- I, ASI Sajal Das of NJP PS, SPC do hereby lodge this complaint against the above noted arrested accused person and others that today i.e. on 28.03.22 at about 14.50 .hrs I received a secret source information that one truck displaying number plate RJ/14/GJ/7023 is coming from Assam side and proceeded towards Kolkata which is loaded with huge quantity of stolen timber (Teak logs). Accordingly, I informed the fact to you and diarised the fact in General diary vide NJP PS GDE No 1288 dated 28.03.22 and as per your kind direction myself along with ASI Khagen Barman, C/1053 Paresh Rava, HG/794 Ranjit Roy, VP/08 Laxman Roy, VP/13 Jamirul Islam, CV/306 Biswajit Roy, CV/824 Niru Kr Yadav & CV/116 Rohit Kr Mahato left for Jatikali More to verify the veracity of the information information in hand. Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender. At 15.25 hrs we arrived at Jatiakali More and started to Naka Checking at Jatiakali More. At about 15.45 hrs we noticed that one turck was coming from Jalpaiguri side but seeing the Naka checking the driver of the said vehicle stopped his vehicle in a consiseratble distance and also noticed that one person came down from the driver cabin and started to fled away. Immediately we reshed to the spot and managed to apprehened one person who was inside the driver cabin. On being asked he disclosed his identity as noted above and also disclosed that he is the Co-driver of the said vehicle. During interrogation he disclosed that seeing the Naka Checking driver stopped the vehicle and fled away. Accordingly, we found the number of the vehicle is RJ/14/GJ/7023 which is matched with our information. Subsequently, we searched the vehicle and found huge number of Teak logs loaded in the said vehicle. On counting it is found that the vehicle loaded with total 32 (Thirty two) numbers of loges of tick timber measuring approx total 495.54 CFT.

On demand the above noted accused person failed to produce any valid documents in respect of the above noted Teak logs loaded in the vehicle as well as failed to produce any documents in respect of the vehicle. Being further interrogated he disclosed that he and his driver in connivance with others and after getting permission of the truck owner they have procured the teak logs clandestinely from Assam by illegal way with a view to sell the same in Kolkata for their personal gain.
