In producing herewith one person namely Rajesh kr, Pandit (52) s/o Lt. Ganesh Pandit of Bhujiapani, Bimannagar Ps. Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling along with the following articles under seizure viz,

- 26 (Twenty six) Bottle K-Bottlers Special Whisky for sale in Arunachal Pradesh (each bottle containing 375 ML)
   Marked as Exhibit "A" from which 01 bottle randomly taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit "A-1",
- 45 (Forty five) Bottle K-Bottlers Special Whisky for sale in Arunachal Pradesh (each bottle containing 180 ML)
   Marked as Exhibit "B" from which 01 bottle randomly taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit "B-1
- 3. One big size hand shopping bag made in nylon.

I, ASI Balaram Roy of Bagdogra Police Station, SPC do hereby lodged this written complaint against the above noted arrested person namely Rajesh kr, Pandit (52) s/o Lt. Ganesh Pandit of Bhujiapani, Bimannagar Ps. Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling to the effect that on 08.05.22 at evening in course of K-35 Mobile van duty vide GDE no 290 at around 18.30 hrs received a secret source information that one person is selling huge quantity of illicit liquor at Bagdogra bazaar area to his designated customers and as per your kind instruction, I along with HG-1187 Sushil Roy, VP-01 Ansalem Kujur, VP-02 Pradip Roy, CV/375 Jogesh. Barman and CV-386 Kishor Ranjan Hawlader rushed at Bagdogra market area to verify the veracity of information. At around 18.45 hrs we reached at Bagdogra bazaar area parked the vehicle in a safe distance and approaching towards Bagdogra market side source point out one person in a distance we cordon him who was carrying a big size shopping bag made in nylon seeing the police team he tried to flee away a hot chase police party managed to apprehended the above noted arrested person who is selling illicit liquors some of his designated customers clandestinely which are kept on his bag size shopping bag presence of police team some customers who was gathered for purchased liquor were flee away to run from the spot. On interrogation Rajesh kr, Pandit admitted that he is run the business since long time to move on different places for his wrongful gain on demand he failed to produce any valid documents or license on support of storing and selling the said huge quantity of illicit liquor recovered from his bag. Accordingly, I seized and labelled the above mentioned illicit liquor recovered on his bag under proper seizure list in presence of witness and arrested him u/s 41 CrPC issuing memo of arrest and inform his ground of arrest. On further interrogation Rajesh kr, Pandit was admitted that previously he also arrested in c/w Bagdogra PS, case no 150/19 Dated; 23.06.19, U/S 3 / 4 WBG & PC Act. The whole process of seizure and labelled was made in between 18.50 hrs to 19.30 hrs. Total 17.850 ltrs illicit liquors.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be recorded against above noted accused Rajesh kr, Pandit (52) s/o Lt. Ganesh Pandit of Bhujiapani, Bimannagar Ps. Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling and arrange for its investigation.
