Respected Sir,

I, Sri Bipul Chanda, S/O Lt. Khitish Chandra Chanda, R/O Deshbandhupara, 109, S.N. Bose Road, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this FIR as follows:

That, my nephew Sri Tirthankar Chanda, S/O Sri Biplab Kumar Chanda, R/O Deshbandhupara, Near Deshbandhu Balika Bidyapith, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, got married with one Smt. Manideepa Chanda, D/O Madhusudan Kundu, of Haldibari on 6th February 2007 and out of the said wedlock one female child named Tanisha Chanda was born. Both Tirthankar and his wife are residing at his said residence.

That since the last few months my brother ,Sri Biplab Kumar Chanda and my said nephew used to tell me that my nephew Sri Tirthankar Chanda was being tremendously tortured by his said wife Smt. Manideepa Chanda and that she would even beat him and abuse him in very filthy language and even used to threaten to kill him. He was scared of her and did not complain previously for fear of further atrocities.

On 9th April the said Smt. Manideepa Chanda entered my nephew's shop room and damaged many articles kept there to be sold and caused great financial loss to my said nephew. She abused him in filthy language in front of out siders who were present in the shop when he tried to stop her.

It has come to our knowledge that the said Smt. Manideepa Chanda is having an extra marital affair with another person and wants to marry the said person and is causing all this trouble to force my nephew to give her a divorce.

Yesterday, i.e. on 25/5/2022 about 11.30 P.M. the said Smt. Manideepa Chanda with the intention to murder my said nephew, Sri Tirthankar Chanda, hit him on the frontal part of his head, with a 'batam' and as a result ,he sustained critical bleeding injuries on his head and had to be admitted to Siliguri Subdivisional Hospital for immediate treatment. He is lying there now in a precarious condition and is fighting against imminent death.

I also came to know that while Tirthankar was lying in the said hospital his wife Manideepa went to the Police Station to lodge a false complaint against him, his family to save herself from being arrested for her offence taking advantage of the situation as all family members were in the hospital.

Sir, under compelling circumstances I am lodging this complaint against Smt. Manideepa Chanda for attempting to murder my nephew Sri Tirthankar Chanda, so I request you to take immediate legal action against Smt. Manideepa Chanda, W/O Sri Tirthankar Chanda D/O Madhusudan Kundu, R/O Deshbandhupara, Near Deshbandhu Balika Bidyapith, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, and thus oblige thereby.
