- complainants submit that their son and daughter in law above named shifted to such rented premises on or about 2014.
- 5. However, despite shifting out of the residence of the complainants, the disputes and differences in between them were not solved and they had been continuing to have differences in their matrimonial life. The complainants submit that since it was a dispute between their son and daughter-in-law, they had preferred not to interfere in such disputes and the entire issue was left for reconciliation and resolved upon them since they were residing separately.
- 6. In such circumstances, for the reasons unknown to the complainants, on or about 30th March, 2022 most surprisingly their daughter in law i.e. Neha Shah alongwith her parents i.e. Ram Kumar Shah, Lila Shah and her brother Kishan Shah all of a sudden without giving any opportunity to the complainants to have a discussion, forcefully entered into the dwelling house and land of the complainants as described in detail herein above. Subsequent to 30th March, 2022, their daughter-in-law alongwith her parents and brother have been continuously residing upon the said property and they have expressed their intention to grab and capture the said property without any lawful justification.
- 7. The complainants submit that as on date their daughter-in-law i.e. Neha Shah alongwith her parents as named above and her brother are residing in the said property without any legal rights in respect thereof. The complainants submit that any matrimonial dispute with their son is a completely separate issue and such dispute cannot be a justification for them to grab and capture the immovable properties including the land and dwelling house of the complainants which they had purchased and constructed out of their own funds. It shall be important to mention herein that till date the complainants have not created any right upon such properties in favour of their son and accordingly their daughter-in-law cannot have any legal right in respect of the said property.

Sub:- Prayer seeking protection of property.

Madam / Sir,

The abovenamed complainants most respectfully beg to prefer this representation / prayer as follows:-

- The complainant no 1 i.e. Jagadish Prasad Shah is the recorded owner having absolute right, title and interest in respect of land admeasuring more or less 0.05 acres and the constructed building situated thereupon at R.S. Plot No.579, L.R. Plot No.50 recorded in R.S. Khatian No.716/2, L.R. Khatian No.528 under Mouza Dabgram, Sheet No.08 corresponding to L.R. Sheet No.45, J.L. No.2 within the police station of Bhaktinagar, Ward No.40 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation. The said property is butted and bounded by the North 37 feet wide S.M.C. Road, South land of M.S. John, East Pradyut Kumar Das and West land of M.S. John.
- 2. The complainants submit that they are senior citizens suffering from various ailments and health issues. They had been residing within the said property since several decades having purchased the said land and having constructed a dwelling house thereupon out of their own hard earned income.
- 3. The complainants submit that their son Sri Sashi Kumar Shah used to reside alongwith them in the said property and while residing with the complainants, Sashi Kumar Shah solemnized a Hindu Marriage with Neha Shah, daughter of Ram Kumar Shah having permanent address at Jaigaon, Bhagath Singh Nagar, opposite B.D. School, Pin-736182. Such marriage was solemnized on or about 30th November, 2013.
- 4. The complainants submit that immediately after the marriage, certain disputes and differences arose in between their son and their daughter-in-law as named hereinabove and since such disputes and differences could not be resolved, their son alongwith their daughter -in-law decided to reside separately in a rented premises situated at lakeon Road. Siliguri, Dist-Darjeeling, Pin-734001. The

- 8. The complainants submit that in terms of the provisions of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, preservation and protection of properties belonging to senior citizens is a statutory obligation cast upon the public authorities. Accordingly, no illegal and / or unlawful interference in the properties of the senior citizens should be tolerated by the public authorities. Despite several verbal representations in this regard to the Inspector-in-charge, Bhaktinagar Police Station, no protection have been granted for preserving and protecting the property of the complainants till date. On the contrary, it appears that the said authority has been instigating and indulging the abovenamed daughter-in-law and her relatives so that they can forcibly enter, grab and continue to possess the said property most illegally thereby interfering with the valuable rights of the complainants.
- 9. In such circumstances, finding no other alternative, the complainants abovenamed have been constrained to prefer this prayer / representation so that their land and property can be preserved and protected from the unlawful interference and aggression by their daughter-in-law and her relatives. The complainants further submit that since they are senior citizens having several ailments, compelling them to approach a Court of law for initiating a litigation may not be a suitable alternative remedy. Accordingly, it is prayed that your goodself shall take immediate and forthwith measures so that their daughter-in-law and her parents and brother can be escorted out from the said property without any further delay.
