I, SI Pradeep Diyali of New Jalpaiguri PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this written complaint against above noted accused persons to the effect that on today i.e 15.07.2022, at about 1845 hrs received a specific source information that one persons would be coming from Jalpaiguri side and proceed towards Bihar with a suspected consignment of Ganja in Boloro Pickup bearing registration No. WB 71A-6673 Accordingly I informed the matter to SI Partha Sarathi Das, O/C New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC and requested him to strengthen by more police personals at Amaidighi, in front of Kedar Hotel Hotel. Hence, I, diarized the fact in GDE vide NJP PS GDE No. 738, and at 1855 hrs I, along with PSI-Newton Biswas, ASI Sajal Das, HG/-794 Ranjit Roy, CV/ 824 Niru Kumar Jadav, CV/306 Biswajit Roy all of NJP PS left PS for Amaidighi, vide NJP PS M.C.C. No. 1101/22 Date: 15.07.2022 to verify the veracity of the information vide GDE No-739 dated 15.07.2022 by Govt. Vehicle taking necessary articles like white paper, Digital weighing machine, Arrest Memo, Seizure List, seal, gala wax, candles, match box etc. At about 1915 hrs we reached at Amaidighi, in front of Kedar Hotel and parked the vehicle at considerable distance and proceeded towards kedar Hotel. Meanwhile, I called two disinterested witnesses namely 1) Kajimul Haque s/o Karimuddin of Amaidighi, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri 2) Amenar Rahaman @ Firoz s/o Azizul Rahaman of Amaidhi, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and also informed the videographer namely Tapan Mandal s/o Tusto Mandal of Bhola More, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to make video of all the produce search and seizure if any. I disclosed our identity and informed them about the information in hand and requested them to accompany us in the whole process of search and seizure, if any. Meanwhile, RT van officer ASI Binay Subba along with force arrived at Amidhi, in front of Kedar Hotel to accompany us in the whole process of search and seizure if any. Subsequently, Our Police party found the vehicle bearing registration no.- WB 71A-6673 parked in front of Kedar Hotel at Amaidighi, PS-NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri with above mentioned accused person. Accordingly we intercept the vehicle and apprehended the accused person i.e one driver. I disclosed our identity to him. On being asked he disclosed his names and address as noted above. I told him about the information in hand but he denied. After prolong interrogation, he admitted that there is Ganja in the vehicle. Then I gave him option that whether he wanted to be searched in presence and supervision of Executive Magistrate or police Gazetted Officer. He agreed to be searched in presence of police Gazetted Officer. Accordingly, I served the Notice in writing and as per provision of law to him which he duly acknowledged by receiving and signing in the copy of Notice. Accordingly, I informed Sri.
