Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Tapash Roy (57) S/O Lt. Gyanandra Chandra Roy of Bhaktinagar Ward No. 35, P.S.-NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with him.

- I. 13 (Thirteen) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit each bottle containing 600 ML.
- II. 06 (Six) bottles of Tuborg Strong Premium Beer each bottle containing 650 ML.

I, PSI-Newton Biswas presently attached with NJP PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 27.08.2022 at 18.50 hrs I received a secret source information that one person namely Tapash Roy (57) S/O Lt. Gyanandra Chandra Roy of Bhaktinagar Ward No. 35, P.S.- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is selling ID liquor illegally at his shop at NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar area near Netaji More under PS- NJP, Dist.-Jalpaiguri. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in the General diary vide NJP PS GDE No. 1355 dated 27.08.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind direction and instruction myself along with VP/ 13 Jamirul Islam, CV/306 Biswajit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for near Netaji More under PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to work out the information in hand. At about 19.25 hrs we arrived NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar area near Netaji More, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and being identified by the source I found the said accused person selling Illegal Distilled liquor to his regular customer at his shop situated near Netaji More, and as per the indication of source managed to apprehended him. During interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above and also disclosed that he is selling ID liquor at his shop at NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar area near Netaji More under NJP P.S since long for his illegal gain. On search the above noted I/D liquor recovered from his possession. On demand he failed to produce any documents/licence in respect of store/sale the I/D liquor recovered from the bag carrying by him Accordingly, I seized the above noted I/D liquor from his possession under proper seizure list and arrested him under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 19.40 hrs to 20.05 hrs.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your kind honour that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused namely Tapash Roy (57) S/O Lt. Gyanandra Chandra Roy of Bhaktinagar Ward No. 35, P.S.- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
