Subject: F.I.R regarding breaking of Electric wire & damage to property of WBSEDCL

Respected Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complain for breakage of Electric wires & Damage of Property of WBSEDCL near Military camp area, Upper Bhanunagar, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist jalpaiguri, by unknown vehicle. Today Morning at around 10.30 hrs of 29.08.2022, a report was received by the undersigned regarding a vehicle damaging Electric Wires over telephone & that Live wires were laying over the road. The LT Mobile maintenance van of PHCCC was sent to site immediately and the report was confirmed by the workers of the Maintenance van. It was found that One Live Electric wire along with the spacers holding it were Broken and lying in a dangerous condition in the middle of the road causing not only a Financial Loss Of WBSEDCL but also was at risk of causing fatal accidents there. On further investigation on site it was observed that there are few transport godowns where heavily loaded vehicles enters and exists on a daily basis, one of which might have caused the wire to break when crossing the bare conductors. When asked about the vehicle which caused the damage to all the godown's personnel, none of them co operated and refused to share any details of any vehicles. Some of the godowns belongs to persons namely SMT.SARALA AGARWALLA, SAURAV KITHANIA, HIROK CHOUDHURY (C/O.ASHUTOSH SAW MILL), SUNITA SINHA etc. This type of similar incidents has been reported from the same area earlier also, and thus there lies a constant risk of accidents related to live conductor electrocution in that area.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against the culprit/s under Section 139 of the Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007 of India and extreme negligence, risking the lives of other individuals.
