In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Bhumika Barman (55yrs), W/o Lt Sudhir Barman of Jaldumur, Sahapara, P.O- Sahu Danga Hat, PS-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:-

1. 12(Twelve) sealed bottles of 600 UP 'Himalayan Gold' Country Sprit containing 600 ml each.

I, ASI. Uday Sankar Bhattacharjee of Ambari Falakata Out Post under NJP PS/SPC lodged a written complainant against the above noted accused person to the effect that today on 04.09.2022 at about 07.55 hrs received source information that one person has gathered huge amount of liquor illegally and selling the same to the local customer at Jaldumur, Sahapara for her wrongful gain. This refers to Ambari Falakata out Post GDE No. 117 dated 04.09.2022. Therefore, I conveyed the same to O/C Ambari Falakata Out Post and as per his instruction I along with 1) L/C-1314 Moumala Roy (2) NVF/ 29 Kiran Roy, (3) LCV-859 Jahanara Khatoun, (4) NVF-0043 Ranjan Das all of Ambari-Falakata OP, Under NJP PS/SPC proceed to Jaldumur, Sahapara to work out veracity of the information. At about 08.15 hrs we have reached at the spot and being identified by the source our police party held raid at Jaldumur, Sahapara, in presence of two independent witnesses namely 1) Abhijit Majumder S/o. Lt. Ashim Majumder of Chakiavita, PO. Kamarvita, PS-NJP Dist-Jalpaiguri and 2) Subash Sarkar S/o. Lt. Narayan Sarkar of 09 No Colony, Ambari-Falakata, PO. Kamarvita, PS-NJP Dist-Jalpaiguri and recovered (i) 12(Twelve) sealed bottles of 600 UP 'Himalayan Gold' Country Sprit containing 600 ml each from the possession of accused person namely Bhumika Barman (55yrs), W/o Lt Sudhir Barman of Jaldumur, Sahapara, P.O- Sahu Danga Hat, PS-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri. On being demand she could not produce any valid license/documents in support of said liquor. She become nervous and admitted her guilt before us and stated that she sells the same to the local villagers since long for her wrongful gain. Accordingly, I have seized the above noted articles under proper seizure list in presence of above noted witnesses and took signature of the accused person and witnesses. The seizure was made in between 08:35 hrs to 08:50 hrs. Therefore, I have arrested the said accused u/s 41 Cr.P.C. and issued Memo of arrest appraising the ground of arrest in presence of witnesses.

I therefore request you that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Bhumika Barman (55yrs), W/o Lt Sudhir Barman of Jaldumur, Sahapara, P.O- Sahu Danga Hat, PS-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri under proper section of law.
