That the complainant thereafter received a call from phone number - 8918049248 claiming/stating himself to be Dr. R.B. Gupta, principal of Katihar Medical College, Katihar and stated that one M.B.B.S. seat has been vacant at Katihar Medical College, Katihar since

- 4. That the complainant was in need and looking for a M.B.B.S. scat in reputed medical college for admission of his daughter namely Harshita Das. In such situation the complainant agreed to his proposal for admission of his daughter in Katihar Medical College against such vacant
- 5. That the accused person claiming himself to be Dr. R.B. Gupta asked the complainant to deposit Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) only in the account of Al-Karim University, Katihar which is the parent organization of Katihar Medical College and as such the complainant deposited Rs. 50,000/- in name of Al-Karim Education Trust, Katihar bearing account no. 34395317131 maintained in State Bank Of India, being transaction ID 199958470 from the complainant's personal bank account namely Mr. Benu Gopal Das bearing Account No. 11089300839 maintained in State Bank Of India, Siliguri Court Branch, Siliguri.
- 6. That the accused person also asked the complainant to deposit Rs. 7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs) only in the account of Miss Sruthi Barman (dropped student) so that the National Medical Council will release the seat and daughter of the complainant can be admitted to Medical College.
- 7. That complainant deposited Rs. 7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs) in the name of Miss Sruthi Barman bearing account no. 920010072782651 maintained in Axis Bank being transaction ID- SBINR52022101008700064 from the Complainant's personal bank account namely Mr. Benu Gopal Das bearing Account No. 11089300839 maintained in State Bank Of India, Siliguri Court Branch, Siliguri.
- 8. That the Accused Person advised the Complainant to proceed to Patna to appear before the BCECE Board, Patna for admission/ registration of the student in the Bihar Medical Council. That after transferring both the aforesaid amount the Complainant proceeded to Patna on the night of 10.10.2022 and was supposed to attend the BCECE Board on 11.10.2022 at 12 noon for admission. On 11.10.2022 at around 10.30am the Accused person called the complainant and asked to deposit another sum of Rs. 98,000/- (Rupees Ninety Eight Thousand) only in the Secondary of Mills South Barman since National Medical Council is not agreeing to release the

seat with Rs. 7,00,000 deposited in name of Miss Sruthi Barman since Miss Sruthi Barman had paid a sum of Rs. 8,50,000/- to the College at the time of her admission.

- 9. That the complainant being induced by the accused person assurance and promise the complainant deposited Rs. 98,000/- (Rupees Ninety Eight Thousand) only in the account of Sruthi Barman bearing account no. 920010072782651 maintained in Axis Bank being transaction ID- SBIN122284907582 from the complainant wife's account namely Mrs. Sujata Das bearing Account No.20052404130 maintained in State Bank of India, Siliguri Court Branch.
 - That after depositing such amount on 11.10.2022, the accused person asked the complainant to wait and attend BCECE Board when the accused person will advice but unfortunately the complainant did not receive any message from the accused person after deposition of Rs. 98,000/- on 11.10.2022.
- 11. That on 12.10.2022 at 10am the complainant received a call from the accused person from phone number (89180-49248) to attend the BCECE Board at 12.30 pm and that all formalities have been completed and admission of the Complainant's daughter will be done today. But after that the mobile of said person claiming to be Dr. R.B. Gupta (Ph 8918049248) has been switched off and thereafter the said accused person did not called the complainant.
- 12. That the complainant got suspicious and thereafter the complainant enquired and searched online regarding the contact number of Dr. R.B. Gupta, Principal of Katihar Medical College and after verification the complainant found that the complainant have been cheated and defrauded by some person who has claimed himself to be Dr. R.B. Gupta.
- 13. That after the enquiry and research the complainant realized that the complainant had fallen prey to a gang of cheats who executed a formidable plan, rife with dubious intent, in a near perfect manner which finally culminated in inducing the complainant to deposit an amount of Rs. 50,000/- in account of Al-Karim Education Trust, Katihar bearing account no.34395317131 and Rs. 7,98,000/- in account of Miss Sruthi Barman bearing account no. 920010072782651.
- 14. That the complainant having no inkling about such devious intentions of the accused persons, firmwho deceived the complainant into depositing said amount of money. The said Accused on identification hereby in collusion with one another have cheated the complainant for their

own personal gain. The actions of the said seed persons clearly fall within the ambit of sections 406/419/420/120B of the harden Penal Code. Their conduct mortgaged the ingredients of the aforementioned offences

15. That the Complainant approached the Panitanki Police Outpost under Siliguri Police Station on 13.10.2022 to lodge his complaint against the accused persons but the Panitanki Police Outpost refused to start any specific case against the accused person and did not initiate any investigation even though the said Complaint clearly discloses cognizable offences.

That the Complainant being aggrieved by refusal on part of Officer-in-charge, Panitanki Outpost under Siliguri Police Station approached the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate and the Complainant thereafter lodged an application under Section 154(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure to the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police T. Occumissionerate on 01.11.2022 but the police authorities are reluctant to take any action regarding the grievances of the Complainant.

- 17. That finding no other alternative, as the local Police Station neither rendered any help nor registered the Complaint or took any action against the Accused Persons as per the Law, the reason best known to them; the Complainant is moving this application under the provision of Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 18. That inspite of all the necessary steps taken by the Complainant, the Complainant has not been able to register his case and has thus approached the Ld. Court for Justice. Moreover, the facts as stated in the Petition clearly presents that the Accused persons has committed cognizable offences for which he is required to be punished under relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code.


