Sir,

I, Mrs Jahnabi Barman (Singha) wife of Mr. Pradip Barman, daughter of Kunal Chandra Singha, resident of village – Ranidanga Post- Ranidanga Police Station - Bagdogra, District – Darjeeling .Pin No.-734012 lodge this F.I.R which is as follows:-

1) That on 11/12/2019 my marriage was solemnized with Mr. Pradip Barman, son of Dinabandhu Barman Village – Ramthenga Post – Ramthenga P.S – Ghoksadanga District – Coochbehar.Pin -735211, West Bengal according to Hindu rite and custom and prior to my marriage, my Parents handed over to the tune of Rs 400000/- (Four Lakhs) as dowry to the family of the Bridegroom through Four Cheques, being no.115937,115938,115939,115940 and those cheques were duly encashed. Not only that at the time of my marriage, my parents also gave gold ornaments such as-

- a) One gold chain of Bridegroom (14.430 gm aprox.)
- b) Two gold ring of Bride groom (5.060gm +7.001gm aprox.)
- c) One gold necklace for bride (22.410gm)
- d) One gold sitahar for bride (26.820gm)
- e) Five gold rings for bride (2.360gm +4.040gm+2.760gm+4.420gm +3.950gm)
- f) Two gold bangles for bride (14.340gm+-----)
- g) One pair of gold earrings for bride (8.660gm)

h) Two pairs of gold ear tops for bride (1042gm+2.420gm)

i) One pair of Sakha + Two pairs of pola + loha covered with gold for bride (21.510gm +-
-----)

j) 10 pairs of ear tops & 6 pieces of nose pins

2) That my parents also gave furniture and accessories such as :

a) Two wooden beds

b) One Almirah

c) One dressing table

d) one alna

e) One Almirah (wooden)

f) Two wardrobes

g) One American Touristor bag

h) Utensils (Kasha) & other Accessories

In spite of giving so many cash and accessories he was not satisfied. After few months of my marriage he started pressurising me to bring further cash of 10,00,000 from my parents house to buy a flat. He used to abuse me in filthy languages and often used to beat me as I refused to bring money from my fathers house.

3) That it was a arranged marriage and my parents after seeing the advertisement in the daily news paper (Uttat Banga Sambad) dated : 23/06/2019 contact with the family of Pradip Barman (my Husband) and in the said advertisement it was mentioned that the Bridegroom (Pradip Barman) is a Railway Junior Engineer in Indian Railways and at present working as Junior Engineer in Indian Railways but after elapse of few months of my marriage I came to know that my husband work as Technician one in Mechanical Department and I understood that I have been cheated by my husband and by my laws but as a society bound Indian lady, I tried my label best to adjust with my husband as well as with my laws.

4) That we started our nuptial life at New colony, Road No.-2, Siliguri Junction in Railway Quarter No. 133/A. And from the very inception of my marriage I realized that my husband have sexual problem . He is a "PERVERT", addicted with pornography, resulting which my husband pressurized me for oral sex as well as for anal sex. Few days back without my consent, my husband forcibly inserted his penis into my rectum resulting which I became ill and traumatized but I could not be able to disclose this shameful event neither to my friends nor to my parents. And the behaviour of my husband is just like a sex- worker. Whenever I am not ready to do such shameful act he compels me to perform and kicks me from bed as a result I often becomes physically sick.

5) That when I went to my paternal house for preparation of SSC CGL 2022 Examination in March 2023. I had been informed by my neighbors of the New Colony that due to my absence, my husband booked sex- worker and spent night with her in the said Railway Quarter. Local people of the vicinity raised their voice against this type of Immoral activities. On the very next day I reached the quarter and raised my voice against such type of activities of my husband but surprising enough my husband was not repentant for that activities on the contrary he had driven me out of that said quarter.

6) That I also came to know that my husband sends money to different people through Uttar Banga Kshetriya Gramin Bank & State Bank of India to different bank accounts behind my back & without my consent. On being asked my husband did not disclose anything to me. I am scared regarding this matter whether my husband having any connection with Antisocial Ailments.

I did not lodged FIR in due time only to save my marriage.

I,therefore praying to you to take necessary legal action against my husband and my laws.
