Bhaktinagar, Dist: Jalpaiguri beg to inform you that, I am
the joint owner of a shop room situated at Bidhan Market,
Siliguri being Numbered as B/7/R. Today, i.e 14/07/2023,
I along with my daughter went to the said shop room and
start some urgent repairing work in the said shop room and
found that there are extra locks put by some one on the
doors of my said shop room. I have informed the market
committee about this incident and they advised me to
break the locks and start our work. At that time one
Ripon Saha, son of Sri Pradip Saha resident of Chayanpara,
near Sakita Bhawan, Ward No. 37 of S.M.C, P.O Rabintra
Sarani, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist: Jalpaiguri, Pin-734006
along with some unknown persons came to the shop room and
threaten us to not to break those locks, That the said Ripon
Saha and his associates scattered all the repairing
materials. They also threatened us that they will not allow
us to open our shop. When we raised our protest to
said Ripon Saha, he pushed me and tried to snatch

my mobile phone. When my daughter came forward to save me at that time said Ripon Saha and his associates beat my daughter and also outrage her modesty.

In view of above facts and circumstances I therefore, request you to look into the matter and take appropriate legal steps against said Ripon Saha and his associates.
