Respected Sir

I, Kushmita Das, wife of Sri Sanjib Sarkar and Daughter of Sri Gouranga Das, presently  
residing at Bhalobasa More, Panchkolguri, P.O. Sahudangihat, P.S. New Jalpaiguri,  
District Jalpaiguri, PIN 735135, West Bengal, would like to state that I am the legally  
wedded wife of Sri Sanjib Sarkar and our marriage was solemnized on 04.03.2022 as  
per Hindu Rites & Customs at Bhojaner Chhora under Nishiganj G.P., Police Station  
Mathabhanga, District Coochbehar.

That my said marriage was arranged by both the family members. That prior to  
marriage, my husband informed my parents that he is/was working as Manager in the  
S.P Gas Agency at Jorpkahri and earning a sum of Rs.22,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two  
Thousand) only per months. That in my marriage my husband and my in-laws has  
demanded a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand) only and other  
ornaments but as my father is a farmer by occupation he hardly manage to provide  
in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and a gold ring for my husband, and other articles such as  
utensils, bedding, etc.

It is pertinent to mention here that my matrimonial house consisted of my husband  
Sanjib Sarkar, son of Sri Khagen Sarkar, my father-in-law Khagen Sarkar son of Late  
Upendra Sarkar, my mother-in-law Anjana Sarkar wife of Khagen Sarkar. That after my  
marriage my sister-in-law Sampa Sarkar wife of Manash and her husband Manash  
Sarkar son of Dilip Sarkar used to visit my matrimonial house frequently and stayed  
there for 15-20 days in a month.

That after my marriage my husband took me to my matrimonial house and we start  
leaving as husband and wife. That soon after my marriage my in-laws and my husband



tie keeping in my mind that one day everything will fine and we start to live a happy conjugal life.

That in the month of May 2023 I came at my parental house to attend the marriage of my elder brother and as such on 24.07.2023 at about 7 p.m. when I return back to my matrimonial house my mother-in-law and father-in-law have refused to enter into the house as such with the help of neighbour and other respectable people I somehow entered into the house alongwith my parents.

It is pertinent to mention here that my mother-in-law and father-in-law only allowed us to enter into the house and when the local people and other respectable person had went their home, my mother-in-law lock all the room and I alongwith my father and mother have forced to stay whole night at baranda.

Under such constrained circumstances I hereby lodge this complaint against my husband and other in-laws and relatives and would request you to do the needful as soon as possible so that the wrongdoers can be punished as per the procedure established by law.
