I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted one accused person to the effect that today on 14.08.23 at 16-05 hrs Myself along with C/851 Chandan Debnath, CV- 375 Jogesh Barman, CV- 386 Kishor Hawlader VP-01 Ansalam kujur left for performing Special evening Mobile duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 746 dt. 14.08.23.
