

1. That your Petitioner above named have filed one Complainant under Section 156 (3) of Cr.P.C for grant of relief and that the contents of the said petition has also been made a part of this petition for all relevant and practical purposes.
2. That your Petitioner is permanent resident of Sevoke Road, Samir Roy Sarani, Paresh Nagar, Ward no - 44, P.O & P.S- Bhaktinagar, District- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal- 734001

3. That Opposite parties do not want that Pampa Roy and Aparna Roy to live with their father Sri Sridam Roy, therefor they always scold petitioner and her sister and father, torture petitioner and her sister and father mentally and physically. They abuse petitioner and also always use abusive language for petitioner, her sister and father in front of whole society. They always threat petitioner. O.P. Sanjita Roy use to click Petitioner filthy photos and videos many times and threat petitioner that Petitioner and her sister should leave their father's home and stay away from their father.
4. That On 18.07.2023 at around 7.30 am they broke the door of Petitioner's room considering the petitioner's sister as a thief, petitioner is working for petitioner's livelihood and for the same reason she comes late in the night around 11.30 pm to 12 am, for the same Opposite parties use different types of filthy languages, they use to speak in front of society that petitioner sleeps with another men and working as prostitute.
5. That on 19.03.2023 at around 03.30 pm opposite parties said petitioner and her sister to leave the house and started conflicts and when petitioner's sister started to defend herself they both (op) started beating petitioner's sister and opposite party no - 1 strangling her and kicked in stomach of petitioner's sister where she was operated on, so, her stomach started bleeding, after that, petitioner came to protect her but opposite parties beat her too. Then petitioner's sister felt unconscious but somehow, petitioner manage to reached to District hospital at Siliguri and got treatments.
6. That opposite parties (Manoj Roy and his wife Sanjita Roy) want petitioner and her sister to leave their house and not stay with their father Sri Sridam Roy, who is a cancer patient, needs a well care and treatments, but opposite parties do not provide him proper foods neither take him to the doctor for proper treatments. And also scold him and use to beat him many time.
7. That day by day their (op) these kinds of offensive behaviouris increasing. Thus, on 18.07.2023 and on 20.03.2023, petitioner's sister lodged F.I.R before the Bhaktinagar Police Station. But petitioner did not get any relief.
8. That they (op) have not stopped behaving cruel to petitioner and her family. Day by day they are showing their more cruel face to petitioner.
9. That on 07.10.2023 father of petitioner got so serious even opposite party no - 2 did not let the petitioner to hospital with intention to kill the petitioner no - 2, even she (op no - 2) stopped the

police to do their work also she locked the door of room where father of the petitioner was suffering from serious illness

10. That it is stated that the petitioner above named thereafter also approached the police to lodge the complaint, then commissioner but they (petitioner and other victims) were asked to take the shelter of the Ld. Court.

11. That from the act and conduct of the accused persons above named, it is clear that the accused persons above named in collusion with each others had/have conspired against the petitioner and had/have also cheated the petitioner and threatened with dire consequences and thereby committed the offence punishable under the law.

Under the above circumstances it is prayed that your honour would be graciously pleased to pass necessary order for grant relief to petitioner and be pleased to pass any other order or orders which your honour may deem fit and proper for the above mentioned reasons for the ends of justice.

And for this act of kindness, the petitioner above named as in duty bound shall ever pray.
