Sir,

In producing herewith following seized articles under proper seizure list -

- 1) Two (02) Packet of SRI VIJAI EXTRA POWER KING COBRA ELECTRIC CRACKERS by Sri Vijay Pyrotechnic Factory Sivakasi (each packet containing 1400 pieces),
- 2) Six packets (06) of COLOUR SPARKLERS by Kailash Sparklers (each packet containing 05 pieces)
- 3) Ten (10) Packets of RAHUL'S CHAMPION COLOUR SPARKLERS by Rahul Industries (each packet containing 10 pieces),
- 4) Forty (40) Packets of PAWAN'S BLACK & WHITE electric Sparklers (each packet containing 10 pieces),
- 5) Twenty(20) Packets of RAJKUMARI ELECTRIC SPARKLERS by Mahabir Factory (each packet containing 10 piece),

I, SI Agen Lepcha of Matigara Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodged this written complaint to the effect that today on 11.11.2023 at 19:30 hrs I received a secret information that one Md. Ramjan (37) S/O Md. Jainal of Matigara Bazaar, PO+PS-Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling has stored huge quantity of Fire-crackers at his shop at Matigara Hat Bazaar for selling the same in the open market for his wrongful gain without having any license or any other valid documents in respect of the same, violating the provision of law which may endanger human life and likely to cause injury of human life. This refers to Matigara PS GDE No- 564, dated 11.11.2023. Accordingly, as per your kind order I along with SI Sailesh Subba, ASI- Dhirendranath Mondal, C/219 Sanatan Chitrakar, C/523 Sanjit Kundu, CVF/643 Animesh Roy, all of Matigara PS, SPC rushed to the spot to work out the information.

On reaching at Matigara Bazaar, I contacted with my source and being guided and identified by the source we proceeded towards the house of the above noted accused person. Seeing police team approaching towards his shop he fled away from the house. Accordingly, I searched his shop and found the above noted seized articles being stored in his shop without any precautionary and safety measures. Subsequently I seized the above noted articles with the help of my police team under proper seizure list.

There is a reason to believe that Md. Ramjan has stored the said consignment of fire crackers for selling the same in the open market for his wrongful gain, which are combustible in nature and endanger to human life and property at shop illegally and violating Govt. Orders. Moreover, the above noted fire crackers were stored without any precautionary and safety measures and thus, violated the section 285/286 of Indian Penal Code. Accordingly, I seized the above noted fire crackers under proper seizure. The whole process of seizure was made between 20:35 Hours to 21:55 Hours. Subsequently, I seized the above noted articles after observing all the formalities.

Under the above fact and circumstance, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly against the accused person namely Md. Ramjan (37) S/O Md. Jainal of Matigara Bazaar Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
