Subject: Report of Money Defraudment Rs. 1,99,700/- through Mobile Phone

I, Dr. Manohar Lal Dhandhania, hereby report a fraudulent transaction that was perpetrated at my business premises - M/s North Bengal Neuro Centre Pvt. Ltd., Pradhan Nagar, Siliguri-734003

It so happened that today i.e 29.12.2023 at 01.00 PM, Dr. Swapan Kumar Saha, a Cardiologist deployed at our nursing home called me on my mobile phone from the nursing home and stated that one army personnel wants to talk to me regarding some pathological tests. I immediately gave attention to the doctor's call since we are empaneled with the ECHS (Employer's contributory health service - an army organization) and they provide a substantial amount of business to our nursing home, I called the person on the number provided to Dr. Saha by the imposter. On Calling, the imposter enquired about some pathological tests and said that there were some tests to be done which amounts to about Rs.1.00 Lacs and he also said that he would pay the amount in advance. For authentication, I asked for an ID proof and in reply the imposter provided me an army canteen smart card in the name of Sandeep Rawat (copy attached) bearing SL. No.LA01121899271700N00. After this, he asked me to start a video call for instructing the payment process. While following the payment process he confused me to such an extent that instead of receiving payment, I ended up paying the impaster. I paid Rs. 49,900/- twice from my HDFC Bank, Sevoke Road Br. (savings A/c No. 05281000032763). The payment was made through GPAY. The imposter had cast such an illusion that it made me feel that I had to pay, and not receive, the payment for the pathological test. While making both the payments, the video caller (the imposter) showed a message that the payment had failed. The payment details, fetched later, of aforesaid fraudulent transaction are follows-UPI ID-336313383669. The beneficiary of the payment for this transaction was a credit card holder (name unknown) of Axis Bank (Branch unknown).

Again, the confusion and pandemonium continued and I again ended up paying the same amount (GPAY Rs.99,900/- once) from my wife's (Mrs. Pushpa Dhandhania) IDBI Bank, Sevoke Road Br. (savings A/c No. 182104000038933), as they had shown me a message of failed transaction on the earlier occasion. The payment details of aforesaid fraudulent transaction are follows - UPI ID- 336396628307 The beneficiary of the payment for this transaction was - Ashish Kumar Patel (bank unknown).

The fraudulent transactions have been reported to the respective banks and both the accounts have been locked for on-line transaction by us.

Sir, you are requested to look into the matter and help us in recovering the defrauded money. Thanking you in anticipation,
