Sir,

I, ASI Dhruba Mishra of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Subodh Thakur (35) S/o Lt. Paltan Thakur of Dakshin Shantinagar PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. Twelve (12) sealed Bottles of Himalayan gold country spirit, each bottle 600 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-A1.
2. Nine (09) sealed Bottles of India made Liquor Kachi 70up, each bottle 300 ml Marked as exhibit -B in which 01 bottle taken as sample for examination exhibit-B1

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today on 23.02.24 at 15-35 hrs Myself along with ASI Khagen Barman, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, C/152 Abdul kayum Miah were performing Special evening Mobile duty vide NJP PS GDE No. 1215 dt. 23.02.24. At 16-15 hrs received secrete source of information that one person was selling Id Liquor illegally from his shop without named at IOC More under New Jalpaiguri PS to its customers without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to O.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself along with other officer and force left for IOC more to verify the veracity of information. On arrival at the spot at 16-25 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from his shop at IOC more, NJP to designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seen the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police. On being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I recovered 1. Twelve (12) sealed Bottles of Himalayan gold country spirit, each bottle 600 ml 2. Nine (09) sealed Bottles of India made Liquor Kachi 70up, each bottle 300 ml from the possession of the apprehended person from his shop and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked he failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C. as It's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. This seizure & arrest was made in between 16-45 hrs and 17-15 hrs (seizure Total approx 9.9 Ltrs).


Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under proper section of law against the arrested person namely Subodh Thakur (35) S/o Lt. Paltan Thakur of Dakshin Shantinagar PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
