Respected Sir,

I, NEHA DAS ROY, resident of Vidyasagar Pally, Burdhaman Road, Ward No. 7, daughter of Late - Paradip Das, W/o Late Ranjit Roy, write you this to inform you that I was married to Ranjit Roy on 08/03/2019 and ever since my marriage my mother-in-law (Sandhya Roy) father-in-law (Raghunath Roy), sister-in-law (Nupur Roy Chowdhury), husband-in-law (Avijit Roy Chowdhury) used to mentally torture, abuse me with slangs and humiliated me. Upon any heated arguments they used to throw utensils at me and break household items. After the marriage my husband and me had a child born on 13/07/2020 namely "Rich Roy". My husband Ranjit Roy passed on 08/11/2023 at Medical College Hospital.

Ever since my husband's death, I suffered severe mental abuse, and physically whenever I tell my mother-in-law and father-in-law that I will stay with them. They used to say that if I went to my husband's house, they will kill me by poisoning my food, or by hanging me to death or by other means. They insults and humiliation from my in-laws house, they used to slang me and my family. After the death of my husband I was forced to leave my matrimonial house and reside at my parental house helplessly in severe grief and mental agony distress.

That my mother has given me two
wheeler "Suzuki Gixxer" in the year 2022 and the E.M.I
is still being borne by my mother. My in-laws refused to
return back the gifted bike and all my necessary college
documents, certificate of birth, LIC Policy documents, my own
vehicle necessary documents, various golden ornaments and
jewelries, besides they also didn't return my son's birth
certificate and school documents and my other vital documents.

Upon demanding these required documents they have
asked me to return a sum of amount of Rs. 75,000/- rupees
(Seventy Five Thousand) stating that my husband has taken
that sum of amount as "debt" and I am his wife so I have
to repay the amount to my in-laws first and until I
do not return the amount to my in-laws, they shall not
return me any of my document or my son's documents.
That due to this incident I am suffering from many
difficulties because those official documents are required for
my son and my personal purposes.

That these painful actions by my in-laws
have caused me severe mental grief and agony and
finding out no other way to save myself from this humiliation
I am forced to file an F.I.R. in this regards.

Moreover, before my husband's death also, I was
tortured mentally and physically by my In laws. My Inlaws
reside at 1. No Dabgoram, Near Handicraft school, Ward - 23

I don't have any one to look after me and
my infant child so i am living in a very small Rented house in
Babupara near YMA mart, Ward - 27

I humbly request you to take an action against
my im-laws house and provide me justice.
