

Sir,

I, SI Tanmay Kundu of NJP PS, Jalpaiguri Police Commissionerate, hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Sanjit Chanda (54) S/o Lt. Nitai Chanda of Janata para, W.No. 35 SMC PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles:

1. - Twelve (12) nos of sealed Bottles of Himalayan Gold Country spirit 0.750 ml each bottle 0.75 ml. Marked as Exhibit A from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination. Marked as Exhibit A1.

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 05.07.24 at 20.25 hrs received source information that one person was selling liquor illegally from the Station road near Railway Guest House without any valid license to his designated customers. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and DC NJP PS and as per his instruction myself along with A.D.Ulam Swarnakar, C/1462 Lajpur Lakhung C/152 Abdul Karim Mubarak of NJP PS, SPC left for near Railway Guest House to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS G.D. No. 315 Dated 05.07.24. On arrival at the spot at 20.45 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from Station road near Railway Guest House to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seeing the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I recovered the above noted articles from his possession and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labeled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said apprehended person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 35(1) BNSS, as it's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made in between 21.15 hrs to 21.55 hrs (seizure Total approx 7.2 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against the above noted arrested person namely Sanjit Chanda (54) S/o Lt. Nitai Chanda of Janata para, W.No. 35 SMC PS NJP Dist. Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
