

OFFENCE COMMITTED: UNDER SECTION 406, 418, 420, 34, 120B, 506 of I.P.C.

The Complainant above named begs to state as follows:-

- That the complainant is a peaceful law abiding citizen of India representing his father Sri Ashok Bhansali, Son of Late Keshrichand Bhansali who is physically disabled and unable to come before this Ld. Court having his address as stated in the cause-title of this application.
- 2. That the case of the complainant in a nutshell is that the accused person no.1 i.e. Suresh Agarwal and accused person no.1 i.e. Rinki Devi Agarwal were the absolute and bonafide owners in possession of one shop room morefully described in the schedule below by virtue of a Deed of Conveyance being No.I-3112/2021 duly registered at the office of the A.D.S.R., Bhaktinagar, Jalpaiguri and had offered to sell the same to the complainant's father and thereafter on 13.04.2021 a Deed of Agreement for Sale' was entered between the accused person no. 1, accused person no.2 and the complainant's father and the total price for the below scheduled shop room was fixed at a total consideration amount of Rs.35,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Lakhs) only. It is partition to state here that on the day of execution of the agreement itself the complainant's had paid a sum of Rs.33,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Three Lakh) only as advance consideration and the accused person no. 1 & 2 also acknowledged the receipt of the said sum.
 - 3. That furthermore it was categorically agreed between the complainant's father and the accused person no. 1 & 2 that the remainder sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh) only being the balance consideration amount would be payable by the complainant's father at the time of registration of the below scheduled office space i.e. six months from the

date of execution of the aforesaid agreement for sale and accordingly the complainant's father made several endeavours within the stipulated period to contact and reach out to the accused person no. 1 & 2 by expressing his desire and willingness to pay the balance consideration and take registry of the below scheduled office space but the accused person no. 1 & 2 failed to execute a Deed of Conveyance in favour of the complainant's father in absolute violation/ contravention of the 'Deed of Agreement for Sale' dated 13.04.2021 and started to make false excuse on one or the other pretext and subsequently the said accused person no. 1 & 2 started to make absurd demand from the complainant's father and demanded an additional sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs) only more over and above the total consideration amount and when the complainant's father did not adhere to their request they both threatened the complainant's father that the accused person no. 1 & 2 will sell the below scheduled shop room to someone else and the complainant's father will not be able to do anything regarding the same.

- 4. That thereafter finding no other alternative the complainant's father sent a legal notice to the accused person no. 1 & 2 but the duo kept completely silent over the entire issue and recently when the complainant's father searched the records of the concerned Additional District Sub Registrar, Bhaktinagar he found out that the duo accused person no. 1 & 2 have already executed a Deed of Conveyance being I-288 for the year 2024, registered in Book No. I, Volume No. 0711-2024, Pages 8187 to 8209 registered at the office of the Additional District Sub-Registrar, Bhaktinagar in favour of accused person no. 3 i.e. Sri Nag Narayan Prasad, accused person no. 4 i.e. Sri Subh Narayan Prasad and accused person no. 5 i.e. Sri Shreenarayan Prasad.
- 5. That the complainant along with his father apprehend that the duo accused person no. 1 & 2 in collusion and connivance with accused person no. 3 i.e. Sri Nag Narayan Prasad, accused person no. 4 i.e. Sri Subh Narayan Prasad and accused person no. 5 i.e. Sri Shreenarayan Prasad have hatched a criminal conspiracy to cheat and have committed fraud upon the complainant's father and have further tried to curtail the complaint's father right upon the below scheduled shop froom.
- 6. That ultimately finding no other alternative on 29.06.2024 the complainant sent a written complaint dated 29.06.2024 to the concerned officer but the concerned officer did not register the said complaint nor did he acknowledge the same.



- A copy of the written complaint dated 29.06.2024 to the Inspector In charge, Bhaktinagar Police Station is filed herewith for Your Honour's perusal
- 7. That the complainant thereafter forwarded the said written complaint u/S.173 (4) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 dated 10.07.2024 for commission of cognizable offence to the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri stating that the offences committed and ingredients of the said written complaint dated 29.06.2024 involves the commission of cognizable offences and prayed to take necessary action but to the complainant's utter dismay all went in vain and till now the concerned police station is neither willing to start a specific criminal case by registering the same as F.I.R nor willing to investigate the matter.
 - A copy of the written complaint dated 10.07.2024 to the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri against the accused persons along with the postal receipts is attached herewith for Your Honour's kind perusal.
- 8. That this complaint is made bona fide and for the ends of justice.

Under the above facts and circumstances, it is, prayed that Your Honour would graciously be pleased to consider this application u/s. 175 (3) of BNSS, 2023 directing Inspector In Charge of Bhaktinagar Police Station to treat this complaint as F.I.R and to start a specific case against the accused persons under proper sections of law and to investigate the case properly and sincerely or to pass such other order/orders as Your Honour may deem fit and proper for the ends of justice.

And for this act of kindness, your petitioner/complainant as in duty bound shall ever pray.
