Sir,

I the undersigned would like to inform you that I am a bonafide tenant in respect of a shop-room situated at Chayan Para, Ward No. 37 of S.M.C., Dist. Jalpaiguri. Very recent my landlord Sri Kamal Paul in collusion with the Branch Manager of State Bank of India, Sevoke Road, Siliguri forcibly put the pad lock on the main entrance of my shop-room keeping all my valuable articles there with an intention to evict me from the said shop-room without due process of law.

I would like to further inform you that I was compelled to file a suit against my landlord and said bank before the court of law and District Judge, Jalpaiguri was pleased to grant an ex-parte interim injunction directing the said bank not to create any third party interest over my shop room without protecting my interest till 02.06.2022 and I have communicated the said order to the bank. (Photocopy of letter dated 13.05.2022 is annexed herewith).

I would like to further inform you that after getting knowledge of the said injunction order, I came to know that my landlord has negotiated the entire premises with one private financier/promoter and deposited the dues to the bank and getting this information, I met with the Bank Manager and requested him to remove the seal and pad lock of the my shop-room but the Bank Manager refused to do the same with a plea that I am not the owner of the said shop-room and he is going to handover the keys of the said shop-room to the landlord and I could realize that Bank Manager, Land owner and promoter they all in collusion with each and other are looking opportunity to evict me from my shop-room for their ulterior motive and illegal gain.


I would like to further inform you that the summer vacation is going on and the court is now closed and I am not in the position to take proper step in the court of law for such illegal act of the Bank Manager, Land owner and promoter and

taking that advantage they all have look opportunity to evict me from my shop-room by violating the injunction order of the Ld. Court.

Under the above circumstances being a helpless poor tenant I would like to humbly request you to protect my interest as a tenant of my shop-room as per the order of the Ld. District Judge, Jalpaiguri otherwise I will face the starvation with my family members and for this act of kindness I will be much obliged.


