Subject: Written Complaint

Respected Sir/Madam,

With due respect and humble submission I, Soni Deb, wife of Liton Choudhury, Daughter of Sanjit Deb, resident of Dakshin Palsh, Natun bazar, P.O. Champasari, P.S. Pradhan Nagar, District- Darjeeling would like to submit that I was married to one Liton Choudhury, son of Sri Dulal Choudhury, resident of North Samar Nagar Bow Bazar, P.O. Salugara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District- Jalpaiguri, and our social marriage took place on 31/01/2024 at the place of my residence at Dakshin Palsh, Natun bazar, P.O. Champasari, P.S. Pradhan Nagar, District- Darjeeling and at the time of my marriage as per the demands of my husband and my in-laws my parents had gifted a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh) only along with gold ornaments (earings) amounting to Rs. 45,000/- (Rupees Forty five thousand) only, one gold ring to my husband amounting to Rs. 28,000/- (Rupees twenty eight thousand) only, Copper utensils amounting to Rs. 5,000/- (rupees Five thousand) only, Bed set amounting to Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) only other miscellaneous things as dowry. It is pertinent to mention here that the total expenditure for my wedding stood at Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Six lakhs) only which also included the cost of catering 500 people.

That after my marriage I started residing with my husband at North Samar Nagar Bow Bazar, P.O. Salugara, P.S. Bhaktinagar, District- Jalpaiguri, and since the first day my husband used to come home in a drunken state and assault me both mentally and physically ordering me to bring in more dowry from my parents as he would start a new business, when I narrated the entire ordeal to my in-laws namely my father-in-law (Dulal Choudhury), and my mother-in-law (Bina Choudhury) and my sister-in-law (Nipa Choudhury) my husband along with my in-laws also supported him stating that what I brought in as dowry was insufficient and they also threatened me with dire consequences if I failed to bring in more dowry from my parents and they also stopped me from narrating the matter to my parents, they also locked me in a room and deprived me of food and eventually I succumbed to their pressure and asked my parents for more dowry as the money they had given as dowry was insufficient for my husband to start a new business. However my parents were not able to fulfill their illegal demand as my parents were already in a debt after my marriage and when they refused to fulfill their illegal demands their torture became more frequent and unbearable day after day.

That I was a Class XII student at the time of my marriage and before my marriage my husband along with my in-laws had assured me and my parents that I would be allowed to continue my studies even after the marriage and subsequently in the month of February, 2024 I returned to my maternal home for my examinations and after finishing my examinations when I returned to my Matrimonial home my father-in-law, mother-in-law along with my sister-in-law started harassing me and also assaulted me physically stating that there is no need to study and I am just required to stay home and do all the house chores and they also threatened me stating that if I desire to pursue any higher education any further they would drive me out of my matrimonial home. It is also pertinent to mention here that

When I was alone at home with my father-in-law he used to physically assault me several times and on 04/03, 2024 my father-in-law grabbed me, assaulting me and he also tried to disrobe me when I objected to the same he threatened that he would burn me alive if I narrated this matter to my parents or my friends and afraid of the consequences I was forced to remain silent.

After the incident my father-in-law and my mother-in-law went to Tripura and in their absence my husband mustered the courage to narrate the entire incident to my husband. My husband sided with his father and blamed me for the entire incident and threatened me stating that if I narrated this matter to anyone I had to face dire consequences. He could also indict me in a false case and being helpless I was bound to remain silent. On the eve of Maha Shivratri in the absence of my husband I narrated the incident to my mother. She supported me and also asked me to return home as she felt that I was being harassed. And being assured by my mother I returned to my matrimonial home to save my marriage.

After returning to my matrimonial home my husband used to call me over the telephone on a regular basis and threatened me stating that he would harm me and my parents verbally on a regular basis and also threatened me stating that he would harm my face and also threaten my family thereafter being afraid of his threat my husband narrated the entire matter to the Panchayat who assured us that he would look into the matter. Subsequently one Panchayat meeting was called in on 19/05/2024. My husband along with my in-laws along with myself and my parents along with my mother-in-law and my in-laws assured the Panchayat and my parents that they would stop all the assaults and that I would live a happy and peaceful life. Trusting upon their words I decided to return to my matrimonial home however my husband has not taken any initiative to take me back.

Kindly you to kindly look into this matter and further take appropriate legal action against the concerned persons.
