Subject: Report of Violence and Vandalism in Hospital Premises Following the Demise of Md Soukat Ali (Hospital UHID: MAHS.25005288; IP41281)

Respected Sir,

I am writing to report an incident of deep violence and vandalism that took place in the premises of our hospital following the unfortunate demise of Mr. Soukat Ali, a 47-year-old resident of Purbabala Bari, Nakugach, Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, 735134. Mr. Ali was admitted to our hospital on 20th March 2025 at 01:34 PM under the supervision of Dr. Rishav Anand, MBBS, MD, FVIR (Interventional Radiologist), Dr. Samarth Agarwal, MBBS, MS, MCh (Uro-Surgery), Dr. Akash Jaiswal, MBBS, MD, DM (Gastroenterology), Dr Anand Jain, MBBS, MD, DNB (Nephrology) and Dr Tanmay Sarkar, MBBS, MD (Anesthesiology & Critical Care), and he passed away on 26th March 2025 at 10:16 PM.

We would like to bring to your attention the following sequence of events:

1. Admission and Medical Care:

- Mr. Ali was admitted on 20th March 2025 under the care of our medical team.
- On 21st March 2025, we provided a detailed case summary, including the patient's medical history, to his family members. We also suggested that they could seek a second opinion if they so wished.
- On 25th March 2025, we convened a Medical Board Meeting with the family, explaining the patient's poor medical condition and lack of improvement.
- On 26th March 2025, the family requested an updated case summary to consult with AIIMS, Patna, for a second opinion and confirmed their intention to transfer Mr. Ali for further treatment and provided accordingly. However, before this transfer could take place, Mr. Ali suffered a sudden cardiac arrest and passed away despite attempts at resuscitation.

2. Sequence of Prior Hospital Admissions:

- Prior to coming to our hospital, Mr. Ali had been admitted to AIG Hospital, Hyderabad, Karnataka, on 7th March 2025 for treatment of Prostatic Abscess with Haematochezia (S/P Haemoclips).
- On 11th March 2025, the family took the discharge of Mr. Ali against medical advice before his treatment was completed.
- The family subsequently started follow-up treatment at Siliguri Star Hospital LLP, Tinbatti More, Siliguri, and on-17th March 2025, Mr. Ali was admitted in an emergency condition.

- After this, the family approached our hospital with a clinical summary from Siliguri Star Hospital LLP, and we admitted Mr. Ali after counseling the family regarding the poor prognosis of the patient's condition.
- Maharaja Agrasen Health Care Centre is a Trust Based Hospital which is dedicated towards society, so we have considered the admission of this patient despite they discharged the patient from the above Two mentioned hospitals.

3. Incident of Vandalism:

- After Mr. Ali's unfortunate passing, approximately 40-50 people, presumably relatives and friends of the deceased, stormed into the hospital premises. The mob became agitated and violently vandalized hospital property, causing substantial damage. Like they have broken the OPD Reception Glass Door, ATM Glass Door, IPD Reception Desktop, Telephone, CCTV Cameras, Digital Sign Board in Front of Lift Lobby (Ground Floor) and Manager On Duty Glass Door etc. And physically assaulted our security guards and abused with our staffs.
- Along with this our OP Pharmacy is also being destroyed and cash drawer is also being damaged.
- The family's grief was understandable, but the violence and destruction that ensued were unprovoked and deeply disturbing.
- We have informed Local Police Station and Police Force came on a short call and took the control over the situation and forced the mob to leave the premises to control further damages.
- Now, the deceased body is lying with us in our mortuary after completing the death care.

Attached herewith of the damaged property CCTV footages for your reference which are self explanatory.

Given the severity of the situation, we request that you kindly investigate the matter and take the necessary action to prevent such incidents from happening in the future. We trust that your office will handle this matter in accordance with the law.

We request you to register the FIR against the accused persons who can be identified in the CCTV Footage.
