In producing herewith (i) One seized Tractor bearing reg. no. WB-73D-8441 loaded with river bed materials i.e Sand along with ignition key.

1 SI Adreesh Ray of Bagdogra Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 19/03/25 while I along with C/540-Mintu Barua and CV/923-Pandit Nagesia were performing evening van duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No-851dated-19/03/25 at about 20.35 hrs I received a secret source of information that one Tractor illegally loaded with river bed materials is coming from Hansqua Side towards Bagdogra to illegally disposed the same. Accordingly 1 informed the matter to on duty GDE officer and as well as the 0/CBagdogra PS and as per his kind direction I along with force immediately left for Kolkata Road on National Highway near Army Track Marshall under Bagdogra PS to verify the veracity of the information. At about 20.45 hrs we reached near Army Track Marshall under Bagdogra PS and started waiting there for the tractor to arrive and after some time at about 20.55 hrs night as indicated by source we noticed that one tractor was coming towards us from Hansqua side but seeing the police van from a considerable distance the driver of the said tractor tried to turn back the vehicle. We signaled the driver of the said tractor to stop but he/she did not have any response to police personnel. Anyhow we intercepted the said tractor but the driver of the said tractor managed to flee away from the spot leaving the said tractor on the road in abundant condition. On search it was found that said Tractor bearing reg. No. WB-73D-8441 was loaded with river bed materials i.e Sand. Thereafter we waited sometimes for the driver or owner of the said tractor to arrive but none appeared before us. I also searched for relevant documents but did not find any documents in favour of the said tractor as well as for the materials. There is a strong reason to believe that the said tractor bearing reg. No. WB-73D-8441 loaded with river bed materials i.e. Sand was stolen by the driver by fraudulent means to clandestinely dispose of the same. Finding no other alternative, I seized the said Tractor bearing reg. no. WB-73D-8441 loaded with river bed materials i.e Sand in abundant condition from the PO i.e near Army Track Marshall as per proper seizure list in presence of witnesses maintaining all formalities of seizure. As per provision the entire process of search and seizure was made by audio/video electronic means which is converted into a Pen Drive and attached herewith. The search & seizure was made in between 21.08 hrs to 21.11 hrs on 19/03/25.

Therefore I pray before you to start a specific case against the driver and the owner of the seized tractors bearing reg. no. WB-73D-8441 under proper section of Law and arrange for its investigation.
