Sub: Complaint regarding physical assault, domestic violence, dowry harassment, and mental torture.

I, Smt. Saraswati Roy, wife of Sri Rahul Dutta, residing at Merry View Tea Estate, P.O. Hatighisha, PIN - 734429, wish to formally lodge a complaint against my husband Rahul Dutta, my father-in-law Ratan Dutta, and my mother-in-law Baby Dutta for subjecting me to severe mental, physical, and financial abuse over the years, culminating in a recent violent incident on 15.03.2025.

On 15.03.2025, after a heated quarrel over the phone with my husband regarding my father-in-law's behavior, I decided to visit my in-laws' residence at Netaji Pally, Rabindra Sarani, Siliguri Municipal Ward No. 22, District - Darjeeling, West Bengal, - 734006. Upon my arrival, my father-in-law, Ratan Dutta, immediately asked me to leave, stating that they no longer considered me a part of their family. As I stood near the main gate, he suddenly kicked it forcefully while I was adjacent to it, clearly intending to injure me. The impact of the kick was strong, resulting in me getting hurt. This incident was not just an act of physical aggression but a deliberate attempt to intimidate and harm me, adding to the years of mental and physical torture I have endured at the hands of my in-laws and husband.

My suffering began in 2015 when I met my husband, Rahul Dutta, on Facebook. Our relationship developed over time, and our families eventually met on 20.09.2015 to discuss about our marriage. During this meeting, my mother-in-law, Baby Dutta, demanded a dowry of Rs. 5,00,000/- from my parents. Due to financial constraints, my family could only provide Rs. 1,00,000/-. This led to humiliation and abuse from my mother-in-law, who insulted us with filthy and degrading language in front of others. Despite this, my husband convinced my

family to proceed with the marriage, which took place on 21.09.2015 at Kalimandir at Ashigarh, Siliguri.

After marriage, my in-laws' behavior towards me was cold and hostile. They constantly pressured me to pay the remaining Rs. 3,50,000/- before agreeing to register our marriage. Eventually, under duress, I gave them the Rs. 3,50,000/- and saved Rs. 2,50,000/- in a fixed deposit in my husband's name at SBI Court More Branch. My in-laws frequently demanded money from my husband out of the amount I kept in fixed deposit, adding to my financial and emotional distress. Over time, their abuse escalated into physical violence. I was deprived of proper food and medical care, and my mother-in-law deliberately gave me food that was medically restricted for my condition. When I objected, she physically assaulted me, throwing a TV remote at my head and dragging me by my hair, causing injuries that I was not allowed to seek medical treatment for.

In 2017, my husband began pressuring me to provide him with a motorcycle. After relentless harassment and emotional blackmail, I finally purchased a Royal Enfield Himalayan for him in 2018 after visiting my maternal home in Bangladesh. While these temporarily eased tensions, my mother-in-law continued her abusive behavior, ensuring that I remained isolated and cut off from my family. I was prevented from communicating with my parents, as my husband refused to recharge my phone to block any contact.

On Dol Jatra in 2021, my husband attended a party hosted by his colleague, Abhishek Chakraborty. When I was unable to reach him in the evening, I sought help from Mr. Bipul Pandey, a former factory assistant manager. Upon finding my husband in a heavily intoxicated state, I brought him home, only to be subjected to further humiliation when one of the men assisting him deliberately touched me inappropriately. When I informed my husband and later reported it to the Tea Estate Manager, my concerns were ignored.

In May 2024, my husband informed me that he was on the list of employees to be laid off. Instead of handling the situation maturely, he began demanding that I fund the construction of a shop near his parental home so he could start a business. Later, in December 2024, he was diagnosed with prostate enlargement, for which I took care of him, ensuring he had his medicines. However, he often refused to take them on time. On 2023, I had also applied for Indian Citizenship, a process my husband and in-laws actively tried to sabotage by attempting to cancel my application for their selfish motives.

By June 2024, my relationship with my in-laws had deteriorated further. Out of concern, I called my father-in-law to inform him about my husband's employment situation, only to be met with insults and threats. He blamed me for his son's condition and told me that if I could not comply with their wishes, I should seek a divorce. From that point onward, my husband became emotionally distant, leading to frequent arguments and worsening our already fragile marriage.

To make matters worse, my in-laws have publicly accused me of theft on multiple occasions, falsely alleging that I stole a gold necklace that was, in reality, gifted to me by my husband's aunt. These baseless accusations, coupled with the repeated instances of violence, harassment, and humiliation, have left me in a state of extreme distress.

Given the continued physical, emotional, and financial abuse inflicted upon me, particularly the violent incident of 15.03.2025, I seek immediate intervention from the police. I request that strict legal action be taken against my husband Rahul Dutta, my father-in-law Ratan Dutta, and my mother-in-law Baby Dutta for domestic violence, dowry harassment, criminal intimidation, physical assault, and mental torture. I also seek protection from further harm and request that a proper investigation be conducted into my claims.

I recently discovered a shocking truth that had been deliberately hidden from me. My husband had been in a relationship with another woman before our marriage, and she had become pregnant. She had filed a complaint against him, and the case was ongoing at the time of our wedding. I was never informed about this. I only learned about it when I found a copy of the complaint. My husband settled the matter with her in 2017 i.e., after our marriage, following which she withdrew the case. This deception was yet another betrayal that caused me immense emotional distress.

I humbly request you to register an FIR under the relevant sections of the law and take necessary action against the accused treating this letter of mine as a complaint. And for this act of kindness, I shall ever be grateful.
