In producing here with seven arrested accused persons namely [1] Jatin Chandra Roy (56 yrs.) s/o Lt. Haripada Roy of Paschim Fatehpur, PO- Uttar Janaki, PS- Rangpur Sadar, dist- Rangpur (Bangladeshi National) [2] Baolo Rani (54 yrs.) w/o Lt. Sumanta Chandra Roy of do [3] Balu Chandra Roy (40) s/o Lt. Anil Chandra of do [4] Golapi Rani (30 yrs.) w/o Balu Chandra Roy of do [5] Smt Zharna Rani (34 yrs.) w/o Jatin Chandra Roy of do, [6] Sajib Roy (19 yrs.) s/o Jatin Chandra Roy of do, and [7] Nirmal Majumdar (60 yrs.), s/o late Ramani Majumdar, a resident of Fokdaibari, PO Goghomali, PS Bhaktinagar, district Jalpaiguri along with seizer articles viz:

[1] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Sree Jatin having D.O.B 15/2/1969 and NID No. 2836985321, issued on 02/07/2017, [2] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Golapi Rani having D.O.B 17/03/1995 and NID No. 4653089138, issued on 26/10/2017, [3] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Sree Balu Chandra having D.O.B 01/04/1985 and NID No. 8238063435 issued on 02/07/2017, [4] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Sree Baolo Rani having D.O.B 01/06/1971 and NID No. 3288038205, issued on 02/07/2017, [5] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Smt. Zharna Rani having D.O.B 23/03/1991 and NID No. 19918514963000102, issued on 07/11/2010, [6] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Gobir Chandra Roy having D.O.B 01/01/2011 and Birth Registration No. 20118514963050637, issued on 31/03/2013, [7] One National ID Card of Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in the name of Bandhan Chandra Roy having D.O.B 26/02/2019 and Birth Registration No. 20198514963060157, issued on 14/11/2021.

I SI Agen Lepcha s/o Lt. Dup Tshering Lepcha of Ashighar Out Post under Bhaktinagar Police Station do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted accused persons to the effect that on April 24, 2025, at approximately 00:15 hours, I received an information that local residents of Fokdaibari have discovered that two family members of a Bangladeshi national have taken shelter in a rented house in Fokdaibari, under Bhaktinagar Police Station. The local community was extremely upset about this situation and was reportedly planning to create chaos as a result. Accordingly I recorded this information in Ashighar OP GDE No. 699 dated April 24, 2025, and informed the Officer-in-Charge of the Ashighar Out Post.

Following the OC's orders, I, along with ASI Tapan Roy, ASI Amit Sarkar, C/970 Bikash Roy, C/1547 Prabir Das, C/1575 Malay Debnath, LCV/861 Tapika Roy, CV/1034 Manojit Barman, and CV/603 Arun Royall from the Ashighar Out Post under Bhaktinagar PS departed for Fokdaibari to verify the information we received.

Around 01:05 hours, we arrived at Fokdaibari and found a large crowd gathered outside the house of a man named Nirmal Majumdar (60), s/o late Ramani Majumdar, a resident of Fokdaibari, PO Goghomali, PS Bhaktinagar, district Jalpaiguri. It became apparent that he had sheltered two Bangladeshi families, for personal gain.

The atmosphere was charged with anger and frustration as local residents voiced their discontent, threatening the individuals inside the house with dire repercussions. Tensions escalated as some in the crowd resorted to throwing stones against the doors, expressing their outrage in a desperate attempt to confront the perceived threat. Therefore to ensure their safety, I brought them to the Ashighar Out Post for their safe custody. I also apprehended the owner of the house Nirmal Majumdar and brought him to Ashighar Out Post for interrogation. Also there were three CCL boys namely Chayan Roy (17 yrs.) s/o Jatin Chandra Roy, Gobir Chandra Roy (14 yrs.) s/o Balu Chandra Roy, and Bandhan Chandra Roy (6 yrs.) s/o do whom I brought to OP for safe custody.

Thereafter in the morning at around 07:05 hrs I interrogated the safe custody persons who disclosed their names as noted above. They admitted that they are Bangladeshi Nationals and infiltrated into India illegally from Bangladesh. On-demand, they could not produce any valid passports or documents to entry into India from Bangladesh. However, they produced before me the seized documents mentioned above which confirmed that they are Bangladeshi nationals. The owner of the house Nirmal Majumdar also admitted that he gave shelter to the Bangladeshi nationals for his gain without verifying the documents. Accordingly, I seized the above-noted documents after preparing a proper seizure list in the presence of witnesses. Following that I arrested them and the owner of the house under proper arrest memo and apprehended minor boys namely Chayan Roy (17 yrs.) s/o Jatin Chandra Roy, Gobir Chandra Roy (14 yrs.) s/o Balu Chandra Roy, and Bandhan Chandra Roy (6 yrs.) s/o do of Paschim Fatehpur, PO- Uttar Janaki, PS- Rangpur Sadar, dist- Rangpur (Bangladeshi National).

On further interrogation it could be learnt that the above-noted accused persons are Bangladeshi nationals and entered into India after crossing Indo- Bangladesh International border without any valid passport or valid documents. The above-noted accused persons violated the provision of the Foreigners Act and are liable for prosecution u/s 14 A. Foreigners Act (Amendment)-2004.

I therefore pray that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against accused persons namely [1] Jatin Chandra Roy (56 yrs.) s/o Lt. Haripada Roy of Paschim Fatehpur, PO- Uttar Janaki, PS- Rangpur Sadar, dist- Rangpur (Bangladeshi National) [2] Baolo Rani (54 yrs.) w/o Lt. Sumanta Chandra Roy of do [3] Balu Chandra Roy (40 yrs.) s/o Lt. Anil Chandra of do [4] Golapi Rani (30 yrs.) w/o Balu Chandra Roy of do [5] Smt Zharna Rani (34 yrs.) w/o Jatin Chandra Roy of do, [6] Sajib Roy (19 yrs.) s/o Jatin Chandra Roy of do and [7] shelterer Nirmal Majumdar (60 yrs.), s/o late Ramani Majumdar, a resident of Fokdaibari, PO Goghomali, PS Bhaktinagar, district Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
