at 10/5/25 at 3:25 PM, I was returning
281/125 (b) BNS Home from my workplace, Titan Eyeplus, located on
and enroute to Hillcrest Road, opposite of main branch SBI, where I
as a my office work as an optometrist. While I was crossing the
Rahman Kund road which was otherwise empty a scooty (vehicle
of KHP TOP number WB24BT4274) approached at high speed on the
wrong side of the road. The scooty had extremely
bright headlights that temporarily blinded me, making it
difficult to see anything clearly. Suddenly, the scooty
hit me directly, and I lost consciousness. I was
later informed that the scooty driver attempted to flee
the scene after hitting me. Fortunately, people in the
area and the toto that saw everything which was
behind that scooty including bystanders from a nearby
restaurant and witnessed the incident. The wife of
the toto driver helped me sit in her toto and collected
my belongings. A crowd gathered and they called my
colleagues as they knew that I work in Titan Eyeplus and
called my mother using my phone. I was immediately
taken to the Fort Hill hospital emergency department at
Darjeeling for medical treatment.
