Respected Sir,

I Seema Mandal (Halder) resident
of Durgadas Banerjee Road, Ashrampara,
Ward No. 14, Siliguri, M. Corp. wish
to lodge an FIR against North
Bengal Sobriety Foundation, located
in Tumbajote, Thankar Road, Matigara
for their gross negligence in providing
medical care and failure to inform me
and my family about the deteriorating
condition of my husband Bikram Halder
who was admitted to the centre on
22nd April 2025 at 6:30 pm. They
went to our address to pick up my

husband.

Despite repeated attempts to obtain updates on his health, the staff Mr Sumit Paul, contact no. 8391862517, either provided vague information or failed to respond. On 25th April 2025 at 5:37 pm

Mr Sumit Paul called and told me to come alone in Siliguri district hospital, informing that my husband have high blood pressure, they took him to hospital for normal check up.

When we and my family members reach there at 6:00 pm, we were shocked to find out that my husband (Bikram Halder) is no more alive, his dead body was in a stretcher in front of the Emergency department of the hospital, wrapped in white cloth sheet and his face was swelled and his eyes, face was blue in colour and foam at the mouth.

This is a clear violation of

the patient's rights and has caused severe emotional trauma and potential physical harm to the patient.

I suspect that the rehabilitation centre has been careless in their duties.

I request you to take strict legal action against the concerned authorities of North Bengal Sobriety foundation and initiate an investigation into the matter.

I am attaching copies of all relevant documents including admission papers and the medical records available.
