Respected sir,

I. **KALPANAN THAPA**, daughter of Late Bhakta Bhahadur Thapa, resident of 34 Nichu Bhanu Nagar, Kabi Agham Singh Road, P.O: Sevoke , P.S: Bhaktinagar, Dist: Jalpaiguri, presently residing at Middle Palash VTC, Champasari, P.O: Champasari, P.S: Pradhannagar, Dist: Darjeeling, Pin: 734003. I am filing this complaint against my husband namely Mahendra Thapa, son of Late D.S Thapa, resident of Middle Palash VTC, Champasari, P.O: Champasari, P.S: Pradhannagar, Dist: Darjeeling, Pin: 734003 to the following effect :-

That I have been married to my husband namely Mahendra Thapa for the past 37 years, and we have two sons who are now married and residing separately with their respective families. From the very beginning of my marriage, I was treated like a servant and never given the respect or status of a wife. My husband was never happy with me and constantly tortured me, both mentally and physically. He often insulted me in front of his family and neighbours, and when I tried to protest, he would beat me and threaten me to keep quiet. He came home drunk almost every day and used to beat me in front of his family whenever I spoke up. He would often threaten to marry another woman. He abused me with filthy language and humiliated me in front of others, knowing I couldn't express myself properly. I was confined at home and prevented from visiting my parents or sharing my suffering with them. In 2022, during Durga Puja, he left the house without informing me or our children. I later found him living with another woman, Astami Rana, and they even have a daughter named Ashmita Thapa, staying together in a rented house. After six months, with the involvement of an NGO called Global Human Rights Peace Foundation and the efforts of both families, we reconciled, and I returned to my matrimonial home. However, soon after, he began mistreating me again. He ignored me, behaved rudely, and continued to physically and mentally torture me day by day, despite my efforts to rebuild our relationship. Over the years, I have been subjected to continuous mental and physical harassment and cruelty at the hands of my husband, compelling me to initiate multiple legal proceedings, including:-

1. A Criminal Case being Pradhannagar P.S. Case No. 285/2023, Dated. 20.04.2023, Under Section 498A/494 of IPC read with Section 3 & 4 of D.P Act which was pending before the Learned Judicial Magistrate (2nd Court) at Siliguri.

2. Maintenance Case being MR Case No. 119/2023 under section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, which was pending before the Learned Judicial Magistrate (4th Court) at Siliguri

3. Domestic Violence Case being Misc Case No. 87/2023 under section 3 & 4 of Domestic Violence Act which was also pending before the Learned Judicial Magistrate (4th Court) at Siliguri

Subsequent to these proceedings, my husband came to me and forced me to vacate the house as because he wanted to sell the house and after a couple of arguments being finding myself helpless I arrived at a mutual understanding to resolve all disputes amicably and dissolve our marriage by way of mutual divorce. Accordingly, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was executed between us, outlining specific terms and conditions for settlement.



One of the primary terms of the said Memorandum of understanding was that a residential house property, situated at Middle Palash, Devi Danga, P.S. - Pradhan Nagar, recorded in L.R. Khatian No.2595, corresponding to R.S. Plot No.160 corresponding to L.R. Plot No. 95, situated within Mouza : Palash, J.L. No. 43, Parghana-Patharghata, Touzi- No.8(91), Police Station - Pradhan Nagar, registered in my husband's name, would be sold, and the sale proceeds amounting to Rs. 42,00,000/- (Rupees Forty one Lakhs Only) would be equally shared between us. My share, as agreed, was Rs. 21,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakhs Only), which would be treated as full and final alimony and settlement of all claims, past and future.

Out of the said amount, I received only Rs. 3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) on 19/02/2025 by cheque bearing No. 568141, issued by one Akash Thapa, the purchaser of the said house. Based on this initial compliance and in good faith, I withdrew all the pending cases referred to above.

As per the agreed terms, the balance amount of Rs. 17, 50,000/- (Rupees seventeen Lakhs fifty thousand only) was to be paid at the time of final hearing of the mutual divorce. Thereafter, I was to vacate the premises voluntarily. However, my husband, in a fraudulent manner and with prior criminal conspiracy in his mind, induced me to sign as a witness to the sale deed during the registration process and, after receiving the full consideration from the purchaser, has neither paid me the remaining sum as promised in the memorandum of understanding nor appeared before the concerned court for the mutual divorce despite three final hearing dates and is currently absconding. He has now taken full benefit by getting the property vacated and registered, while leaving me uncompensated and betrayed. It is pertinent to mention here that One Bivor Thapa, son of Mahendra Thapa, being the associate of the accused person in this crime, have actively participated in the execution of this conspiracy from the initial stage and also involved in inducing me to sign as a witness to the sale deed during the registration process by giving false assurance that I will receive my balance amount without any delay. Later on I came to know that the said Bivor Thapa made deals with the purchaser, received part payments from the purchaser on behalf of Mahendra Thapa and misappropriated the said money.

These acts clearly constitute cheating, criminal breach of trust, and deliberate dishonest inducement to withdraw cases and sign official documents.

I request you to kindly register an FIR against Mahendra Thapa, investigate the matter thoroughly, and take strict action against him to secure justice.
