Sir,

I, Dolon Sarkar, daughter of Maran Chandra Sarkar, resident of 187 Jamalda, Post Office – Thunkijhar, Police Station – Mekhliganj, District – Cooch Behar, respectfully submit the following statement:

On 23/11/2023, my social marriage was solemnized with Sukumar Das, son of Laxman Das, resident of Majhabari, Post Office – Ghogomali, District – Jalpaiguri, in accordance with Hindu rituals and customs.

Since the date of marriage, my husband has been verbally abusing me using filthy language without any valid reason. His mother, Anna Das, and father, Laxman Das, have also been instigating him and escalating the situation. This behavior began during the “Bride’s Feast.” I was raised in a rural area, and my parents had to sell cows and trees and take loans from others to arrange my marriage, my husband and his parents had taken Rs.4,000,00/- in cash as a Bride money, and also taken Gold ring for my husband, Khat, Showcase, Dressing Table , Almirah, Trunk and so many were also given in the hope of saving my marriage, neither I nor my parents initially raised any objections to their abusive behavior.

After marriage, my husband and mother-in-law repeatedly pressured me to ask my father to send money for my husband’s proposed business involving lights, fans, and other electrical items. In January 2024, my father somehow managed to provide Rs. 25,000 in cash. My husband further forced me to ask my father for a gold chain for him. My mother-in-law also consistently demanded expensive gifts, such as gold bangles.

In February 2024, when I visited my parental home and returned, I discovered that all my wedding gifts, including gold ornaments, had been taken from my room by my mother-in-law. When I asked her to return them, she refused. A local “Salishi Sabha” (village mediation) was convened with community members and their family to resolve the matter, but no satisfactory outcome was achieved.

Following the “Salishi Sabha,” my mother-in-law intensified her abuse. She often denied me food and prohibited me from entering the kitchen. On 2/5/2025, when I protested after being kept hungry for more than two days, she entered my room and tried to kill me by pressing a pillow against my face in order to suffocate me. Afterward, she detained me inside the room and locked the room from outside.

Later that day, when my husband returned home and unlocked the room, I tried to explain the incident. In response, he slapped me. When I cried for help, he covered my mouth with his hand and beat me with a leather belt.

When my parents came to visit me on 04/05/2025, they were not allowed to enter the house. My in-laws verbally abused them using filthy and indecent language that cannot be uttered in a civil or social setting. Furthermore, my husband, along with his parents, threw my clothes into the yard and forcibly evicted me from the house in front of my parents. They also physically pushed and forced my parents out of their premises.

I request you to kindly take appropriate legal action against the accused persons based on the above facts and ensure justice to me.
