**Subject: Theft Complaint Against Staff Member Mr. Sagar Darjee -  
Caught on CCTV for Theft of Mobile Phones Worth Rs. 64,000/- and  
Absconding - Request for Immediate Legal Action.**

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, VASKAR GHOSH, S/o Late Prabir Ghosh, the owner of "GHOSH ELECTRONICS", located at Airport More, P.O. & P.S. - Bagdogra, Dist. Darjeeling, Pin. 734014, West Bengal. I am writing to formally lodge a complaint against my staff member, Mr. Sagar Darjee, for committing a serious act of theft and subsequently absconding.

That on 23.05.2025 approximately between 01:10 P.M. to 01:45 P.M., during my absence from the shop, Sagar Darjee is suspected of stealing mobile phones from my establishment. The theft came to my attention when I reached my said shop at approximately around 01:45 P.M., I noticed discrepancies in the inventory. After detecting the loss, I conducted an internal investigation and reviewed the CCTV footage from the relevant time period. I found below-mentioned mobile phones missing from stock and reviewed the CCTV footage, The CCTV footage clearly shows Mr. Sagar Darjee handling and assembling the stolen mobile phones in a suspicious manner that indicates preparation for theft. Also, the video footage clearly shows the individual in question taking the phone without permission. Additionally, the same individual was recorded attempting to disable or turn off the CCTV system shortly after the theft occurred — indicating an effort to conceal the crime. Fortunately, I have successfully backed up the entire footage for investigation purposes. This footage strongly suggests premeditated intent and involvement in the act of theft.

The following mobile phones were found to be stolen:

The incident pertains to the unauthorized removal and theft of mobile phones from my premises, with the total value amounting to Rs. 64,000/- (Rupees Sixty-Four Thousand Only). Upon internal investigation, it was



found that Mr. Sagar Darjee, who was entrusted with certain responsibilities related to daily operations and handling of mobile devices at my mobile shop, conspired to commit this theft.

Upon discovering the loss, I immediately tried to contact Mr. Sagar Darjee through phone calls and messages, but received no response. I also personally visited his known residential address in an effort to recover the stolen items and resolve the matter. However, he was not present at his residence, and it has come to my attention that he has been absconding since the incident. All attempts to establish contact with him have failed, and his current whereabouts are unknown.

I have reason to believe that Mr. Sagar Darjee intentionally fled to avoid responsibility, and I now seek the assistance of the police to locate him and recover the stolen items and also to prevent further misconduct. I believe this matter now warrants immediate legal attention.

Therefore, I request you to kindly register my complaint and take appropriate **legal action against Mr. Sagar Darjee**, as per the provisions of law. I am prepared to provide any further information or documents you may require in the course of your investigation.

**I am hereby requesting the following actions:**

1. **Registration of an FIR** under relevant sections of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, for theft and criminal conspiracy and tampering with evidence;
2. **Immediate investigation** into the matter, including locating and apprehending the accused individual.
3. **Recovery of the stolen articles** or appropriate compensation.
4. **Prosecution of the accused person** as per applicable laws to ensure justice.



I am fully prepared to cooperate with the investigation and will provide all necessary documents to support this complaint, including sufficient internal evidence of Mr. Sagar Darjee's direct involvement in this criminal activity. This includes the CCTV footage clearly capturing the incident, as well as the original purchase bills of the stolen mobile phones. These materials will be submitted along with this complaint for your examination and further action.

I request your good office to take immediate and appropriate legal action in this matter. I am ready to cooperate fully with the investigation or documentation required to assist with the investigation and can provide:

1. A copy of the CCTV footage,
2. Identification of the staff involved, and
3. Any other relevant details as needed.

**Please treat this matter with urgency, as it involves a serious breach of trust and has resulted in significant financial loss to my business. The actions of the individual in question have severely disrupted the daily operations and overall functioning of my business.**

I am willing to cooperate fully and provide any further information
