In producing herewith the accused person namely Amit Thapa, aged 24 yrs, s/o- Late Man Bahadur Thapa, resident of Railway Colony, Station more, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) under custody along with following seized articles under proper seizure list:

1. Ten (10) ltrs 'Chullu' in one plastic jar and marked as Exhibit-A.
2. Eight (08) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60° UP India Made Liquor, each contains 600 ml @ Rs. 160/-, out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit-B.
3. Four (04) bottles of Tuborg Strong Premium Beer, each contains 650 ml @ Rs. 160/-, out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit-C.

(Total 17.40 ltrs, total value Rs. 1920/-)

I, ASI Amit Lama of Bagdogra PS, S.P.C, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Amit Thapa, aged 24 yrs, s/o- Late Man Bahadur Thapa, resident of Railway Colony, Station more, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) to the effect that on 28.05.2025 at 16:45 hrs received reliable source information that one suspect has been proceeding towards Railway Colony, Station more with a huge quantity of liquor illegally for its clandestine disposal for his wrongful gain. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and as per his direction I along with SI Debabrata Kundu, SI Binup Mahato, C/1509 Sourav Roy Sarkar, CV/375 Jogesh Barman & CV/389 Janak Singh left for Railway Colony, Station more under Bagdogra PS, SPC to work out the secret source information. This refers to Bagdogra PS GDE No. 1336 dated 28.05.2025. At around 17:05 hrs we reached at Railway Colony, Station more and made an ambush there. After a lapse of time, being indication & identification by source we held raid at the service road of AH-02 at Station more and detained one suspect there with the help of accompanying Police personnel and interrogated him. On interrogation, he revealed his identity as Amit Thapa, aged 24 yrs, s/o- Late Man Bahadur Thapa, resident of Railway Colony, Station more, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified). We disclosed our identity to him and the input we had. We contacted with the local people to be present as witness during the process of search, seizure, if any. But none agreed to be present there as witness. Then, we searched the person in presence of the Police personnel. On search, the above noted liquor was recovered from his possession. On demand, he failed to produce any valid document/license for carrying, possessing & selling that liquor. He confessed that he had been carrying, possessing & selling liquor illegally since long time for his wrongful gain. His involvement is well transpired in this case. Accordingly, I seized that liquor (as noted above) under proper seizure list and at last, I arrested the involved accused Amit Thapa (as noted above) after observing all legal formalities and communicating him the ground of arrest as he has committed a cognizable offence in presence of Police for carrying, possessing & selling that liquor illegally and issued memo of arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest was made in between 18:50 hrs and 19:05 hrs on 28.05.2025. The entire process of search, seizure & arrest is done through audio-video electronic means using mobile phone and then the same audio-video record is converted to a pen drive using computer system.

Therefore, I request that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused person namely Amit Thapa, aged 24 yrs, s/o- Late Man Bahadur Thapa, resident of Railway Colony, Station more, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) and arrange for its investigation.
