Subject: Request for Protection and Action Against Domestic Violence and Harassment by
Husband

Respected Madam/Sir,

I, Kabita Darnal, aged 39 years, residing at Utsab Squarehood Apartment Phase 1,
Kalamjote, Kadamatala, Siliguri, West Bengal, am writing this complaint to report repeated
acts of domestic violence, verbal abuse, mental harassment, and public nuisance
committed by my husband Santosh Darnal, who works at the Air Force Station and visits
our home regularly on Fridays.

For the past several years, my husband has been:

Abusing me physically and mentally,

Using extremely foul and threatening language in front of our children,

Creating a public disturbance in our residential society,

Causing emotional harm and fear in me and our children, Samavid Darnal and Saanvi
Darnal, who are both minors and fully dependent on me.

Despite repeated requests and warnings, he continues this behaviour every week,
especially on Fridays, when he visits our apartment. On these days, he:

Threatens to beat me,

Verbally abuses our children and me loudly in front of neighbours,

Disturbs the peace and security of the society,

Makes us live in constant fear.

My husband's abusive behaviour has also deeply affected our children — my son Samavir Darnal and my daughter Saanvi Darnal. He frequently uses abusive language in front of them, threatens them, and creates fear in their minds. Both children are suffering mentally and emotionally due to this ongoing harassment.

Our society members have also complained about his behaviour, and we fear that the situation could become more dangerous.

I am currently not employed, have no independent income, and am fully dependent on my husband. However, his behaviour has made it impossible to live peacefully or safely. I am also worried about the safety and well-being of my children.

Therefore, I humbly request:

1. Immediate protection from my husband under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.
2. That he be restrained from entering our house, society, or contacting us in any way.
3. That necessary steps be taken to prevent him from harassing us, either directly or through threats.
4. If required, referral to the Magistrate's Court for a Protection Order.
5. Guidance for further legal action, including free legal aid if available.

We are mentally, emotionally, and physically disturbed due to his actions. I request you to treat this as an urgent and serious matter and take immediate action to ensure our safety.
