Brief Facts:

The complainant above named most respectfully begs to state as follows: -

- 1) The complainant is a peace loving, law abiding and a senior citizen of India.
- 2) The above named complainant is a manager of 'M/S South North Roadways Private Limited', having its head office at 116/4, M.G. Road, (behind Madho Bhawan), Kolkata-700 007 and local office at 'Mittal Complex', Opposite to Anandalok Hospital, Sevoke Road, P.O. Siliguri, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist: Jalpaiguri and the company has been carrying on its transportation business with high reputation for last 30 years with full satisfaction of its customers and without out any complaint from any corner.

The accused no. 1 is the private limited company, having their office at Punjabi Para, Siliguri, P.O. & P.S. Siliguri, Dist: Darjeeling. The accused no.2 is one of its directors of the accused no.1, who has been dealing all affairs and day-to-works of the accused no.1-company and also responsible of the offence, as stated herein below.

3) However, the complainant's company, in course of its transportation business, on 06.01.2025, received an order, thereby certain Consigner, namely 'M/S Unite Corporation Resources', having its office at 136, Netaji Road, Khagra, Beharmpore, Dist: Murshidabad booked freight from its concern for the consignee 'M/s Tista Decocem Pvt. Ltd.' to deliver one equipment i.e. 'Rotary Dryer' at the factory of





said consignee at Jatiakali, P.O. Fulbari, Dist: Jalpaiguri and thereafter a vehicle of complainant's company, having registration no. WB25D-8142 was used for transportation of said equipment from Kolkata to Siliguri, having 'Consignment Note' bearing no. 011-14112.

4) In transit from Kolkata to Siliguri, on 09.01.2025 the said vehicle was detained and seized by the GST Officials at Ghoshpukur, Siliguri in relation with certain discrepancies in the invoice or papers pertaining to such consignment and informed the driver that there were lacunas on the part of the Consignee i.e. 'M/s Tista Decocem Pvt. Ltd' and accordingly complainant's company communicated with Sri Ashok Sarogi, that is, one of the directors of the consignee, who was throughout in contact with the complainant's company since loading of the consignment at Kolkata as aforesaid, about this problem and said Ashok Sarogi i.e. the accused no.2 assured to look into the matter and would inform the complainant.

Be that as it may, in spite of specific assurance to deal with such issue by the accused no. 2, when ultimately negotiation in between him and the GST officials failed, the vehicle was detained by the department concern along with the consignment for about 21 days, causing extreme hardship to the complainant's company and severe financial loss. At this juncture, the complainant fervently requested the accused no. 2 to pursue the matter so that the detained vehicle of the complainant's company could be released and further financial loss for such detention would be minimized. However, at this, the accused no. 2 then requested the complainant to negotiate with the





department regarding the imposed taxation and further requested to pay the same to the department concern for early releasing of his consignment i.e. 'Rotary Dryer', as well as the detained vehicle with the clear assurance and promise to repay every single farthing towards liability to the GST department, as well as the detention charge of the complainant's vehicle, being no. WB 25D-8142.

- 5) After such assurance of the accused no. 2, the complainant paid a sum of Rs. 2,61,000.00 (Rupees two lacs sixty one thousand) only to the GST department against proper receipt as fine for and on behalf of both the accused no.1, as the accused no. 2 specially assured and promised to return back the entire amount once his equipment will be released from the GST department. Consequently, the complainant's company not only paid the fine to the GST department but also paid other charges and had to bear 21 days detention charge Rs. 54,000.00 (Rupees fifty four thousand) with further gross business loss, not less than a sum of Rs. 1,50,000.00 (Rupees one lac).
- 6) In order to release the vehicle and equipment of the accused, the complainant and its company had to incur a huge amount all together of Rs. 4,65,000.00 (Rupees four lacs sixty five thousand) only as aforesaid, as per the instruction given by said Ashok Sarogi i.e. the accused no. 2 and further he assured for paying the total amount at the time of receiving the machine/equipment-consignment. Subsequently after the release of the said vehicle and equipment, the complainant requested the accused no. 2 to pay the amount of Rs. 3,15,500.00 (Rupees three lacs fifteen thousand) only, except the amount of business-loss, as abovenoted, but said Ashok Sarogi

i.e. the accused no.2 most surprisingly denied to pay any amount to the complainant and further threatened to initiate a false case against the complainant and their company. However, noticing the dilatory tactics and evasive response for the payment, as aforesaid from the accused no. 2, the complainant intimated the entire incident to its Association i.e. 'Siliguri Road Transport Association' and in turn, the Secretary of the Association issued letter to the Commissioner, Siliguri Metropolitan Police, I.C, Bhaktinagar Police Station, Federation of Chamber of Commerce and Industry, North Bengal (FOCIN) etc. on 11.02.2025 about the incident. Subsequently, the Secretary, FOCIN also issued another letter to the Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Siliguri Police Commissionarate on 13.02.2025. The complainant also lodged a complainant on 18.02.2025 to the Commissioner, Siliguri Metropolitan of Police.

- 7) However, most surprisingly the complainant received a notice under Section 35(3) of BNSS from Bhaktinagar Police Station and from the complaint came to know that instead of paying the legitimate amount of the complainant, said Asok Sarogi i.e. the accused no. 2 lodged a false complaint against them on 16.02.2025, being Bhaktinagar Police Case No. 155 of 2025, under Section 312(3)/318(4), 351(2). 3(5) of BNS and in connection with such police case, the equipment was also seized and eventually released unto the favour of the accused no.1.
- 8) The complainant from the above direct threat of the accused no.2 and also the above criminal proceeding could realize about the oblique and mal intention of the accuseds and about such fraudulent activities, cheating, criminal breach of trust, misappropriate of

fund, extortion etc. of the accused persons, the complainant lodged one written complainant to the Commissioner of Police Siliguri P.C. on 27.02.2025 and Inspector-in-Charge, Bhaktinagar Police Station on 26.02.2025 through e-mail thereby requesting to start a criminal case against the accuseds for such criminal breach of trust and misappropriate of money, cheating and extortion with dishonest and fraudulent intention. Since the concern Police Station did not receive the complainant, therefore it was sent through registered post with a/d on 27.02.2025 but till date no legal action or producing has been started against the accuseds.
