With due respect, I, **SRI PRADIP KARMAKAR**, Son of Late Prafulla Karmakar, Resident of College Para, Siliguri, P.O. & P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, would like to lodge this Written Complaint before your authority to the effect that I am one of the Director of "**Bidhan Jewellery Works**", A Unit of PMI Ventures Pvt. Ltd., having our two Jewellery Shops/Outlets situated at Siliguri Area, one of which located at Bidhan Market, Siliguri and another one is located at Hill Card Road, Opp. Meghdut Cinema Hall, Siliguri.

Sir, today i.e. on 22/06/2025, I along with my family members including my son namely Ipsit Karmakar, who is also one of the Director of Bidhan Jewellery Works, A Unit of PMI Ventures Pvt. Ltd., went to Malbazar, Dist. Jalpaiguri for outing purpose, keeping our said Jewellery Shop located at Hill Cart Road, Opp. Meghdut Cinema Hall, Siliguri, open and our engaged Employees/Workers were remain present in the said shop since the business hours of the said shop.

Today i.e. on 22/06/2025 during the business hours of the said shop, at around 11.30 A.M., two male and one female persons introducing themselves as the Customers, entered into our said Jewellery Shop located at Hill Cart Road, Opp. Meghdut Cinema Hall, Siliguri and told our employees to show some golden chain and accordingly, as per the desire of the customers, our employees showed some Golden Chains to them and finally, they

have chosen one Golden Chain, valued about Rs. 80,000/- only but at that moment, they have told our employees that they do not have sufficient amount with them and they would come at about 2.30 P.M. at the shop with cash and purchase the said Golden Chain from our shop and thereafter, they left our shop.

Thereafter, at about 02.30 P.M. to 02.45 P.M., those three persons again came and entered into our shop and asked our employees to show the said Golden Chain which they have choose earlier and at that time, the lady customer wear the said golden chain on her neck to check whether the same is suitable on her or not. Suddenly, another lady customer entered into our shop and sat on a different location in the shop and when our employees asked the earlier customers whether they are known to each other or not and in reply, they stated that they are not acquainted with the said lady. In the meantime, the customers who wants to purchase the said Golden Chains, asked our employees to provide them with some Soft Drinks and accordingly, one of our employee namely Lakpa Doma Sherpa bring some soft drinks for the customer.

Suddenly, two male persons who were standing just in front of our said shop, came towards our shop and assaulted and pushed our Guard/Gate Keeper namely Sagar Thapa inside the shop room and another two male persons attacked upon our another Guard/Gate Keeper namely Rakshit Debnath, who was standing outside the shop, and pushed him also into the said shop forcibly and during that time, two female persons left from our said shop and all the six male persons entered into our shop and closed the main gate of our said shop from outside through their another person, who was monitoring the situation from the outside.

Immediately after entering into our said shop, all of a sudden, all the six male members bring out the Fire Arms/Guns

from their pockets and pointed out their Guns/Fire Arms towards our employees/workers and asked and threatened them to raise their hands-up and to come out from their respective Counters and sit on their knees together in a corner and out of fear of death, my employees/workers do the same and thereafter, the miscreants have tied the hands of our employees/workers with the plastic thread and taking advantage of the said moment, the aforesaid six male persons have looted all the Jewelleries which includes Gold, Silver, Platinum, Diamond etc. from our said shop. It is to be mentioned here that our said shop is covered under the surveillance of CCTV Cameras and the entire incidents have been captured/recorded in the CCTV Cameras.

Sir, while I along with my family members were at Malbazar, my son namely Ipsit Karmakar, who is also one of the Director of Bidhan Jewellery Works, A Unit of PMI Ventures Pvt. Ltd., tried to contact with the employees of our said shop over phone but nobody picked up his phone calls and did not make any response and out of curiosity, my son open the CCTV Cameras through his Mobile Phone and noticed that all the employees of our said shop are sat on their knees by raising their hands up and six male persons were looting the Jewelleries from the said shop and immediately after seeing the same, he informed me and on being informed by my son, I informed the same to my friends, well-wishers as well as the Police Personnel and requested them to visit our said shop immediately.

Receiving such information from me, the Police Personnel of Siliguri Police Station arrived at our said shop and knowing about the presence of Police Personnel, all the aforesaid miscreants have succeed to flee away from the said shop and looted the entire jewelries from our shop. Thereafter, I along with my family return back at Siliguri and went to our shop and the employees/workers have narrated the entire incident to me and after going through the stock record, it is found that the Jewelleries

which have been looted by the miscreants including Gold, Silver, Platinum, Diamond etc., were valued Rs. 11,00,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Crores) approximately though, the actual amount of the looted jewelries can be ascertained only after doing tally with the entire stock register. It is also pertinent to mention here that from our employees/workers, it has also come to learn that all the above miscreants were talking with each other in Hindi Language.

Sir, it is my strong apprehension that all the aforesaid male miscreants and the said two female miscreants with preplanned and organized manner have entered into our said shop to commit dacoity in the brought daylight and looted the entire Jewelries including Gold, Silver, Platinum, Diamond etc., valued Rs. 11,00,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Crores) approximately from our said shop, by putting our employees/workers under the threat of Death by pointing the Fire Arms/Guns towards the Employees/Workers.

I, therefore, request you to kindly investigate into the matter properly after treating my complaint as an FIR and find out all the miscreants who are involved in the aforesaid crime and recover all the valuable jewelries and also to take appropriate strong legal action against the aforesaid miscreants as per the provision of law and oblige thereby.

Your early action is highly solicited.
