Respected Sir,

I am Govind Prasad, a resident of ISKCON Mandir Road, Siliguri, residing opposite Ganesh Bhawan. I am writing to formally lodge a complaint regarding a highly disturbing and alarming incident that occurred in our locality.

Today, at approximately 6:00 AM, when I stepped out of my residence to dispose of household trash, I witnessed a horrific scene just outside our main gate. A young local man was sexually abusing a stray dog—an animal known in our neighborhood for its calm and non-aggressive nature.

On witnessing this inhumane act, I immediately raised my voice in protest. The accused, however, managed to flee the scene before he could be identified or apprehended. This incident has not only deeply shaken me but also raised serious concerns about the safety of the community, especially for children and vulnerable individuals, as such disturbed and dangerous behavior can easily escalate to more violent crimes.

Following the incident, I immediately called a local paravet, Mr. Sanjay Saha, for emergency help. He promptly arrived at the location and provided first aid to the injured animal, helping to stop the bleeding and stabilize its condition.

Later, when I along with other local residents inquired further, we were able to identify the individual involved as Mr. Rajiv Chauhan, son of Late Rama Sankar Chauhan. He is known to have a permanent residence on Bhola Chauhan Road, beside the Borough Office.

I also request that regular patrolling be intensified in the area, especially during early morning and late-night hours, to prevent such incidents in the future and to ensure the safety of both humans and animals in the locality.

Thank you for your attention and understanding. I hope prompt action will be taken to bring the perpetrator to justice.
