Subject:--Complaint Against Forceful Dispossession, Vandalism and Criminal Intimidation over my lawful tenanted property at 1.30 pm. the premises situated at R.S. Khatian No. 387/1 corresponding to L.R. Khatian No. 234 (Old), 241 (New), comprised within R.S. Plot No. 200 and L.R. Plot Nos. 60, 61, 11 under L.R. Sheet No. 83 at Mouja – Debgram, Pargana – Baikunthapur, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri.

Respected Sir,

I, Dipankar Ghosh, son of Chandra Kanta Ghosh, resident of Village Vandhupur, P.O. Sutra, Dist. Purba Burdwan, Pin - 7135130, am a lawful tenant over the premises situated at R.S. Khatian No. 387/1 corresponding to L.R. Khatian No. 234 (Old), 241 (New), comprised within R.S. Plot No. 200 and L.R. Plot Nos. 60, 61, 11 under L.R. Sheet No. 83 at Mouja – Debgram, Pargana – Baikunthapur, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri.

The said land is owned by Sri Anjan Kumar Das, son of Gobinda Chandra Das, who mortgaged the same property with Punjab National Bank. Pursuant to proceedings before the Debt Recovery Tribunal, Siliguri, the bank obtained a possession notice under the SARFAESI Act and the possession was supposed to be executed on 03.07.2025 with assistance from your police station.

However, I have obtained a lawful injunction order from the Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Jalpaiguri, restraining my eviction from the said premises. Despite presenting the said court order to the recovery director namely Shantosh Kumar of Qubex Recovery Private Limited hired as well as appointed by the said alleged bank and the authorized officer of the alleged bank namely Dipak Kumar Sah on 03.07.2025, in unlawful connivance with a group of persons comprising auction purchaser Sri Bishal Agarwal, his associates, and agents—accompanied by police personnel and an Executive Magistrate—entered the premises forcibly. They ransacked my residence, vandalized furniture and valuable articles, and humiliated me physically and verbally in front of local residents, using intimidation and coercion, thereby dispossessed me unlawfully from my tenanted property thereafter the said

perpetrators locked the entire premises blocking the ingress and egress ousting me out from the said tenanted property. Imperative therefore, my relentless approach regarding consideration of the said injunction (Stay) Order passed by the competent Civil Judge Junior Division, Jalpaigurihas blatantly been bypassed by the Executive Magistrate even by the police personnel also. However, the perpetrators were so desperate and audacious that they have consistently remained overpowered in spite of the presence of competent authority as well as police personnel.

This unlawful intrusion and contemptuous disregard of a competent civil court's injunction amounts to criminal trespass, theft, vandalism, intimidation, and wrongful dispossession under relevant provisions of the IPC and SARFAESI guidelines.

I therefore request you to:

- Register my complaint and initiate an FIR under appropriate sections of IPC including Sections 448, 427, 379, 506, and 120B corresponding to sections 329, 324, 303, 351 and 61 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023
- Investigate the role of the auction purchaser, recovery agents, and others involved in the act.
- Take appropriate steps to restore possession and safeguard my tenancy rights.
