Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused namely Ram Barman (24), S/O- Shiveshwar Barman of Patiram Jote, Kola Bagan, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling along with one seized vehicle bearing Reg. No. WB-73-B-0509 partially loaded with river bed materials, I ASI Pema Dorjee Sherpa of Matigara P.S, SPC do hereby lodge a Complaint to the effect that on 09.07.2025 at around 17:10 hrs while I was at Matigara PS received an information from reliable source that some people are loading illegally mining riverbed materials on a Bolero Pick Up at Chotu Ghat, Rana Nagar under Matigara PS. On receiving the information I along with forces namely C/868 Sujal Roy, C/219 Sanatan Chitrakar and C/523 Sanjit Kundu rushed towards Chotu Ghat, Rana Nagar to work out the information. This refers to Matigara PS GDE No- 440, Dt- 09.07.2025. Under information and kind order of I/C Matigara P.S on arrival at Chotu Ghat, Rana Nagar under Matigara P.S area, I found few people are loading illegally mining riverbed materials on a Bolero Pick Up bearing Reg. No. WB-73-B-0509. On seeing the police team all escaped from the spot however we managed to apprehend the driver of the above said vehicle and asked the driver to produce valid documents / papers of the said riverbed materials, which was loaded in the vehicle but he failed to produce any valid documents in support of said materials. There was a sufficient reason to believe that the above noted accused driver and the owner of above noted vehicle has procured the river bed materials illegally without any legal royalty/ papers as per rule, for selling clandestinely for their wrongful gain. Also there is a sufficient reason to believe that the above noted accused driver and the owner of above noted Bolero Pick-up is loading a river bed materials from Rana Nagar, near Chotu Ghat under Matigara P.S. by violating the norms under MMDR Act as well as by violating the order of Green Tribunal. Accordingly I seized the above noted Bolero Pick Up bearing Reg. No. WB-73-B-0509 partially loaded with riverbed materials under proper seizure list and arrested the driver namely Ram Barman (24), S/O- Shiveshwar Barman of Patiram Jote, Kola Bagan, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling under proper memo of arrest. The whole process of search, seizure and arrest was made on 09.07.2025 in between 17:35 hrs to 17:50 hrs. The whole process of seizure was made under videography.

Therefore I pray before you a specific case may kindly be started against the driver named Ram Barman (24), S/O- Shiveshwar Barman of Patiram Jote, Kola Bagan, P.S- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and the owner of the vehicle bearing Reg. No. WB-73-B-0509 under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
