Proposed Sections:- 281/106 (1) of BNS

The complainant above named begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is a law abiding and peaceful citizen having his hearth and home in the above noted address.
- 2) That on May 25, 2025, at approximately 01:(0 AM, when the elder on, Gopal Sarkar, and younger son, Krishna Sarker, of de-facto complainant, were moving from Ashighar towards Ambar 10 visit a relative's ouse. When they reached Sahudangi Canal Ros I, Ambari, a mote cycle, bearing no. WB72Q5193 being driven in a 4sh and negligent manner, struck his elder son from behind. As a rest s, his elder son sustained grievous injuries. The motorcycle rider also fe . on the road and sustained minor injuries.

The younger son of de-facto complainant, immediately informed Bhorer Alo Police Station about the incident over the phone and called local residents for assistance in taking the elder son to the hospital. The motorcycle rider, upon seeing the gathering of local people, fled from the spot with his motorcycle. The younger son, with the help of local residents, transported the elder son to NBMC & Hospital, Siliguri, where the attending doctor declared him "brought dead." The post-mortem examination of Gopal Sarkar, was conducted at NBMC & Hospital, Siliguri, as per Matigara P.S. UD Case No. 568/25, dated May 25, 2025.

3) The accident took place due to rash and negligent driving by the rider of the offending motorcycle, bearing no. WB72Q5193 and he should be punished as per law.
