This is to inform you that certain beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban)/Housing for All (Urban) scheme have received the 1st instalment of financial assistance under PMAY-HFA (U) for the construction of their dwelling units. However, these beneficiaries have failed to commence the construction work within the prescribed time period. Despite issuance of multiple notices and reminders by Siliguri Municipal Corporation, these individuals have neither initiated the construction of their respective houses nor refunded the sanctioned amount to the Government Exchequer. Such non-utilization of public funds for the designated purpose and willful refusal to refund the amount constitutes misappropriation of public money, causing wrongful loss to the Government and wrongful gain to the concerned beneficiaries.

As per the direction of the Director of SUDA & State Mission Director, PMAY-HFA(U), conveyed through Memo No. SUDA-11915(99)/4/2020-HFA SEC-SUDA/4020 dated 11.06.2025, you are hereby requested to take necessary legal action against the defaulting beneficiaries under the relevant provisions of law.

For your reference, a detailed list of defaulting beneficiaries along with supporting documents is enclosed herewith.

You are requested to treat this matter as most urgent and initiate appropriate legal proceedings in accordance with law
